

Junior Advisory Hockey Committee

Terms of Reference

Purpose of the Committee	<p>The Junior Advisory Hockey Committee (JAHC) will assist and advise Hockey Queensland the perspectives of young people in hockey:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • State Championships and events. • Education. • Uniforms. • Pathways • Junior Participation • Gender Diversity
Membership	<p>Membership of the Committee will promote gender balance and will consist of:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Chairperson – appointed by HQld • 4 general members. • HQ Education & Pathways Manager will also attend the committee meetings but will not be considered a member of the committee.
EOI's and Criteria	<p>EOI's for positions will be called for by HQ in August. Appointment process will be followed as per the Committee Charter.</p>
Quorum	<p>The quorum of meetings shall be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Committees with 5 or fewer members - 3 members
Delegated Authority	<p>The JAHC will undertake its responsibilities and make recommendations for improvement to HQ in the following areas:</p>
1. State Championships & Events	<p>Provide advice in relation to the game policies and tournament rules and regulations in regard to juniors. Advise HQ the results of consultations regarding special projects eg: Olympic legacy from a 2032 player lens. Liaise with the Hockey Qld office on event requirements if required.</p>
2. Education	<p>The JAHC will work with the HQ Office to advise on :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Plan and coordinate junior coach education and development opportunities • Plan and coordinate junior umpire education and development opportunities • Plan and coordinate junior technical education and development opportunities • Plan and coordinate junior player education and development opportunities • Plan and coordinate junior volunteer education and development opportunities

3. Uniforms	The JAHC will provide advice and recommendations to the HQ Office regarding suitable uniforms for competing in, taking into account the diverse body types.
4. Pathways	The JAHC will provide advice to the HQ Office to regarding pathways for all members. This includes players, umpires, coaches, technical officiating and volunteers.
5. Gender diversity	The JAHC will provide advice and recommendations to the HQ Office regarding gender diverse guidelines and how they are applied and may affect junior participation.
6. Junior Participation	The JAHC will provide advice to the HQ Office to regarding participation amongst junior members and how to increase participation numbers in junior demographic.
7. Special Projects	The JAHC will work with the HQ Office to plan and prepare special events and projects to support Hockey when appropriate.
8. Communication	The JAHC will provide advice and messages to be distributed to the Community from the HQ Office. The HQ office will manage all communications with advice from the Committee.
9. Reporting	Provide minutes to the HQ Board via designated portal and report progress to the HQ Board.
