2024 AGE ELIGIBILITY

For the purposes of determining player age eligibility the following shall apply for the 2024 HV Summer competitions:

2024 SUMMER COMPETITION LOCAL RULES

Matches will be played in accordance with the FIH Rules of Hockey 2022 and with Hockey Victoria Rules & Regulations except as stated otherwise by these rules.

MATCH PLAY

The duration of the games shall be two halves of twenty-five (25) minutes with an interval of five (5) minutes at half time and at the conclusion of each game. Matches should commence as per the fixture, and games must run to scheduled times due to lighting restrictions at some venues.

The first named team should provide the match ball.

PLAYER ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible to play in a final's match with a particular team, a player must have played at least 3 matches as a registered member with that team.

An eligible player is limited to playing in one final match per final round in that particular competition. Once an eligible player has played a final match with a particular team in a competition, they must play with that particular team for the remainder of the finals rounds in that competition.

EXTREME WEATHER

Extreme weather may be defined as weather that threatens the immediate or long-term safety of individuals, because of rain, hail, lightening, wind chill or heat. The risk is determined in conjunction with Sport Medicine Australia's Guidelines as well as the Bureau of Meteorology's forecast conditions.

In the event of extreme weather being forecast the following process shall apply:

- Matches shall be cancelled if the forecast temperature will exceed the "Extreme Weather Determinant" on the above table, at the time of scheduled match.
- 2. Any cancellation of a match or round of matches will be advised to all teams by notification of a news alert on the HV website by 11am on the day of the match. It is the responsibility of each team and the rostered umpires to check the Hockey Victoria website for any "Extreme Weather Alert" on the HV Website here
- 3. The "Extreme Temperature" will apply to all "daytime" matches only. It is not envisaged that the above excessive temperatures will be an issue for summer evening matches.

MIXED COMPETITIONS

Additional conditions of play only applicable in ALL Mixed Competitions (Mixed in title)

(a) Teams shall have a maximum of five (5) male players on the field at any one time, plus a goalkeeper of either gender on the field at any one time.

Note: Where a team is short of players, a maximum number of five (5) male field players only, are permitted to take the field at any one time, however additional female players are permitted to take the field.

- (b) GK options available as per FIH Rules.
- Penalty Corners: a female must take the initial shot at goal regardless of the gender of the goalkeeper. Note: (c) In the case where the umpire determines that the ball has been deliberately played outside the 5-yard line in order to circumnavigate this rule, the umpire may determine that the Penalty Corner is still continuing and that a female is still required to take the first shot at goal - i.e. set plays.
- (d) Penalty Strokes: the penalty stroke striker must be female unless the goalkeeper defending the penalty stroke is male, (then the penalty stroke may be taken by either a male or female player).

GUARDIAN HOCKEY (HALF-FIELD)

- Guardian Hockey is played with up to 7 players, with a maximum of three (3) seniors on the pitch at a given a) time (plus a goalkeeper of any age on the field at any one time.) Note: Where a team is short of players, a maximum number of three (3) senior players only, are permitted to take the field at any one time, however additional junior players are permitted to take the field.
- b) NO HITTING or "Tomahawks", slap hitting is permitted if it follows Rule c (below).
- No lifting the ball above knee height. The height will be adjudicated if it passes above 460mm or backboard c) height (around knee height on a grown person)
- Non deliberate fouls by the defense inside the circle, a free hit will be awarded 3 metres from the circle to d) the attacking team. All players must then be at least 3m from the free hit.
- Deliberate fouls by the defense whilst inside the circle, will be awarded a 1v1 with the GK. 6 seconds will be e) allocated to the shootout. If the team defending a Shootout does not have a GK, then an automatic goal will be awarded.
- f) A junior player must wear a facemask to participate in defending a penalty corner.
- Penalty Shootout: the penalty shootout striker must be a junior unless the goalkeeper defending the penalty g) shootout is a senior player, (then the penalty shootout may be taken by either a junior or senior player).

PAYMENT OF UMPIRES

Your team entry fees cover the payment of rostered umpires. The Rostered umpires will be paid through HV. If a club has to provide an Umpire, the payments will be paid directly to the club, for you to distribute to the club umpire.

You won't have to do anything to get the payments directed to the club.

Your team assigned games will be processed with all the other umpire payments at the end of the round. In the below example, Casey White, will be set into the payment automatically as Casey Hockey Club, and in that pay cycle, Casey Hockey club will get the umpire payment.

Please advise <u>ddeefholts@hockeyvictoria.org.au</u> (preferred), by the day after if either your team didn't umpire, or another team didn't attend the appointment, so we can adjust the payments.

ROSTERING OF UMPIRES

Where HV Umpires are NOT appointed (or fail to attend):

- **One HV umpire provided**: If one umpire is provided it is then the responsibility of the named team on the roster to provide an umpire for the duration of that match.
- **No HV umpires provided**: If no umpires are provided it is then the responsibility of the named teams on the roster to provide an umpire for the duration of the match.

Where a team provides an umpire, they will be reimbursed by Hockey Victoria accordingly.

Please note that penalties for not providing an umpire as required are outlined below and may be applied:

- \$50 first offense
- \$200 second offense
- Loss of 3 points for a third offense
