# AusChamps 2024 Champion Lakes Armadale 17-21 April 2024

Champion lakes regatta centre is purpose built for community, state, national and international competitions.

Spanning over 55 hectares Champion Lakes Regatta Centre regularly hosts training and competitions for rowing, canoeing, dragon boating, triathlon and more. With parkland surrounds, barbecue facilities and dedicated public swimming areas the venue is also popular amongst the local community.

The Lake is located approximately 21 km south east of the Perth CBD and approximately 4.5 km north of the Armadale Town Centre.

#### **The Course**

Champion Lakes is a 2000m course with 8 lanes at 13.5m (108m in total) are to be provided with an added 11m on the northern and southern sides of the course.



## **Starting Pontoons**

Starts will be pontoon starts. We are looking at a hand rail for the Sweeps to hold prior to the start. This will reduce the number of boat handlers required and potential injuries for both sweeps and volunteers.



#### **Boats**

Two fleets of 20s Champion boats, plus a spare, and two fleets of tens Peishing boats. We plan on using 6 lanes, 7 if required (20's only) to reduce heats, so 2 fleets of 20's boats and 2 fleets of 10's boats. This may result in the program being slightly different from previous years mixing 20's racing in with 10's racing.

The boats will be weighed prior to the event using compression load cells. The load cells are 120ml in diameter with button on top. We will use 2 for front and 2 for back with a piece of timber across front 2 and same for back. Because we are a not for profit, the supplier will provide at no charge.



### First aid and risk management

The first aid will be managed by St Johns Ambulance and the risk management through ERMS who have a sponsorship agreement with AusDBF.

## **Boat loading**

Boat loading will be from the beach in front of the Control Tower. Crews will go from Marshalling, down a marked path and get in their boats.

When unloading crews will be directed along the front of the loading area and off on a path on the right away from Marshalling.



# **Umpire boats and rescue boats**

We are hiring from Rowing WA umpire boats and rescue boats. There will be four umpire boats and three rescue boats, two for following down the course and one for miscellaneous trips such as food runs and people moving.




#### **Control Tower**


