1. Rules

This event is governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing

2. Sailing Instructions

The SI and a map of the sailing area will be available to download at the time of entry.

3. Eligibility and Entry

- 3.1 Open to all classes
- 3.2 Minimum three boats for a division. Six boats of the same class to constitute a class division. The BRSC may, at its discretion, alter, combine, or add divisions.
- 3.3 All participants must be a current member of an Australian Sailing affiliated club or have acquired a Sail Pass (available here).
- 3.4 Entry Fee per boat:

Single handed \$40, Two handed \$50, Three or more crew \$60.

Juniors half price, Single day entry half price

4. Schedule and Timing (AEDT)

Sat 17 Feb 2024	One long course race, start and finish at BRSC	Start not before 1.30pm
Sun 18 Feb 2024	2 or 3 shorter course races	First race not before 9.30am
Briefing on the Saturday at 12.30pm		
Courses to be set on the day and displayed as soon as practicable.		

5. Scoring and Prizes

- 5.1 Low point scoring. All races to count (no drops)
- 5.2 Prizes awarded asap after the last race on Sunday

6. Insurance

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$10,000,000AUD per incident or the equivalent.

7. Risk Statement

RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes

8. Accommodation and meals
