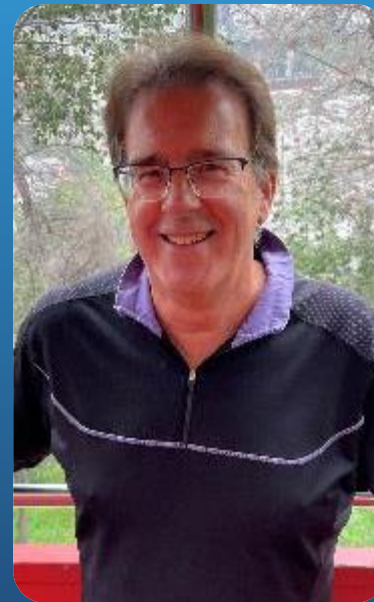

OLYMPIC QUALIFICATION

CONTINENTAL CHAMPIONSHIPS - PHASE 2

- Only the champion in each of the four (4) individual events shall obtain a quota place for his/her federation.
- An individual athlete may obtain only one (1) quota place per individual event for his/her federation.
- If a diver that wins an event at the championships has already qualified a spot for a federation no spot will be offered.

AQUA RULE - WITHDRAWALS

- The member federation of any competitor who withdraws from the preliminary after the Team Leaders Meeting or from a semi-final or final more than thirty (30) minutes after the preliminaries or semi-finals of the event in which qualification was earned, shall pay without excuse to the World Aquatics the sum of one-hundred (100) Swiss francs

- AQUA Rules apply
- Individual Platform events is 10m only
- Individual Events - 7 Judges



COMPETITION RULES

DIVE SHEETS

- The statement of dives must be submitted no later than 24-hours before the preliminary competition in each event
- OR: The referee may accept any statement of dives after the 24-hour deadline, 3 hours before the preliminary competition with a fine of \$250AUS
- At the conclusion of the Preliminary event statement of dives can be changed within 30min at the competition office.

- Final - Top 12 divers from the preliminary

ENTRIES

Individual

- No restriction on number of entries from each federation



COMPETITION PROTOCOLS

PRELIMINARIES

- No introduction of divers for Preliminaries

FINALS

- Introduction of divers for finals
 - Finalists will be introduced before the start of the final
 - Athletes will be required in the marshaling approximately 10min prior to start of introduction
 - Athletes will march out and introduced individually
 - Approximately 15min warm up





COMPETITION PROTOCOLS

OPENING CEREMONY

- The Opening Ceremony will be held on Thursday 30 November at the pool at 1:00pm
- All available divers are required to meet in the Marshalling Area by 12:50pm
- Divers are expected to dress in National Team Uniform

VICTORY CEREMONIES

- Victory Ceremonies will take place at the end of each day
- Please ensure athletes being awarded are in the Marshalling area ready for each ceremony
