

1. Managers must check their details are correct on RevolutioniseSPORT before the Championships.
2. Managers are required to be able to produce the signed Code of Conduct Form for their team should they be requested to by the Tournament Director.
3. Please ensure judges required for all your games.
4. You are to ensure player, team official and spectator behaviour for your team shows good sportsman ship.
5. Teams will need to be finalised on RevSport (inc Player Shirt Numbers). Should any changes be made after this you will need to notify the TD at least 90mins before your first round match and this should be completed at the venue.
6. Managers are required to update their match-card at half-time of the game prior ensuring starting line up and subs are included
7. The team listed first on the draw is to use the left hand bench/dugout as judged when facing the field from the bench.
8. Misconduct – To be dealt with by Technical official on each game or by the TD. Abusive or derogatory remarks will not be tolerated and offenders may be ordered from the bench area.
9. Player Suspensions – penalty points for cards will operate – a player receiving 10 penalty points will automatically be suspended for one or more matches, penalty points shall revert to 5 after serving a suspension. Green – 1, Yellow (Minor) – 4, Yellow (Major) - 6, Red –10.
10. Dress Code –Shin guards and mouth guards MUST be worn, jewellery & watches removed or where not possible – taped. Captains must be clearly visible.
11. Injuries – Wait for the umpire to advise if help needed. A bleeding player must leave the field immediately and change clothing if necessary. Professionally trained First Aid will be at each Championship to use if required.
12. Substitutions – To be made at the half way line, remind players to watch out for the umpires. If a goalkeeper is to be substituted it will be completed with the assistance of a technical person and/or the umpire. The game must be stopped before this substitution takes place. You need a fully padded goalkeeper at all times in underage championships.
13. Signing of match sheets by managers. Carefully check that the score and goal scorers are correct.
14. Managers/Players will be notified via email of the game times for Sundays games. These will be completed on Saturday night by officials. This will also be available on the Hockey NSW website.
15. Drawn final – No extra time will be played with Grand Finals going to a one on one competition. Under 13s will not have one on ones these Championships will be declared with Joint Winners.
16. Any questions on umpiring are to be directed to the Umpire’s Manager. No approach is to be made to individual umpires.
17. Please read the Hockey NSW State Championships Operations Manual before the Championship. This covers the majority of questions that you may have.
