

HOW TO REGISTER CORRECTLY

Do you want to represent your Association at State Championships?

Having the correct registration in the Revolutionise Sport database is essential to ensure your eligibility.

TERMINOLOGY

Primary Registration:

Association in which a player plays hockey on a regular basis.*

Secondary Registration:

Association in which a player plays some of their hockey in addition to their Primary.

Centre of Origin:

Association in which a player played most of their early hockey and has historic ties.

Country Selection:

Players residing in the Metropolitan region (Brisbane). are not eligible.

* If this is the case for more than one association, the primary association will be the association of first registration within that calendar year unless changed with a transfer

CLEARANCES & BENEFITS

Benefits of Primary Registration:

Primary registered players may be eligible for Development sessions offered within their Association
And eligible for selection for representative teams. A Secondary registered player may not be eligible for Development sessions in that same Association and requires a clearance for Representation

Player Clearance:

Primary Associations need to grant clearances for players who want to represent a secondary association. A clearance is to be requested through the appropriate form

REGISTRATION TYPES

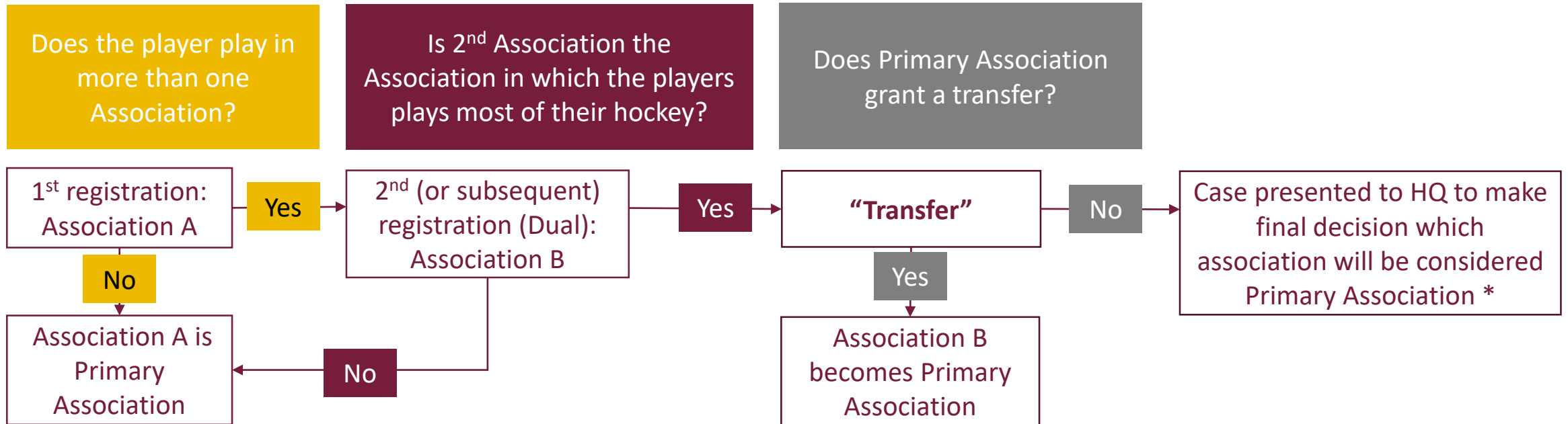
1. Primary (Single) Association registration
2. Primary (Single) Association registration + Centre of Origin
3. Primary Association registration + Secondary Association
4. Primary Association registration + Secondary Association + Centre of Origin

TRANSFERS/CLEARANCES - PROCESS



- * If the Primary Association is not equal to the Centre of Origin the player represents the Centre of Origin for Hockey Queensland Championships.
- ** For Under-age Championships a clearance from the Primary Association is required for anyone wanting to represent a secondary association. Clearances can only be rejected with due cause.
- *** If the player resides in Metropolitan area (Brisbane) the player is ineligible for Country selection, irrespective of their Primary Association or Centre of Origin
