

Umpire/Technical Official Mentor Program

The Hockey Queensland Umpire/Technical Official Mentor Program provides Associations throughout Queensland with the opportunity to develop the knowledge and skills of their local umpires and technical officials.

The Umpire/Technical Official Mentor Program utilises the skills and experience of advanced and national level umpires and officials throughout Queensland to provide support to Associations throughout the state through the delivery of seminars or workshops, on-the-field support and individual advice.

Hockey Queensland is in a unique situation whereby we have many resident umpires/ technical officials who currently umpire/officiate at a national and international level. These umpires and technical officials have the skills and experience to assist other umpires and technical officials to develop their skills.

How are the Umpire/Technical Official Mentors Selected?

Mentors are selected based on their experience at state, national and international level. Each mentor holds a nationally recognised accreditation, with many mentors holding National and International qualifications.

Not only do our mentors have the accreditation and experience, they also have a passion for developing umpires and technical officials at all levels and assisting Associations to provide quality competitions.

Where do the Umpire/Technical Official Mentors go?

Mentors travel to all Associations throughout Queensland. When a Mentor is selected, they indicate their availability to travel to regions within Queensland.

How can Associations be Involved?

The Mentor Program is coordinated through the Hockey Queensland office.

HOCKEY ED LEVEL 1 UMPIRE COACH COURSE

HOCKEY ED LEVEL 1 TECHNICAL COURSE

HQ conducts this course to provide the mandatory prerequisite theory component for technical officials wishing to complete a Level 1 Technical qualification.

A minimum of eight participants are required to conduct the course. HQ encourages Associations to work together to plan a course in conjunction with a championship/event to provide the required learning opportunity for technical officials.
