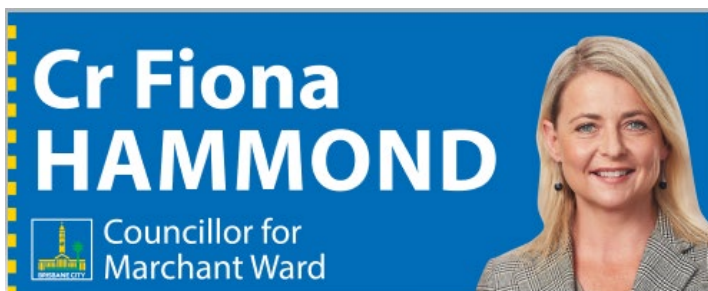

# PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT

## Acknowledgement and Acceptance

As a player representing Hockey Queensland or any affiliated Association in an event that is conducted or sanctioned by Hockey Queensland or any affiliated Association, you must meet the following requirements with regard to your behaviour:

- Behave in a sporting manner at all times to all players, officials and spectators.
- Don't make detrimental statements in respect of the performance of any match officials or umpires.
- Play by the rules at all times and ensure that the game of hockey is not brought into disrepute by your actions.
- Do not engage in inappropriate and/or physical contact with players or officials during the course of play.
- Accept responsibility for all actions taken. Exercise reasonable care to prevent injury by ensuring that you play within the rules. Reasonable care consists of showing due diligence in abiding by the rules and adhering to the officials decisions.
- Adhere to the Anti-Doping Policy advocated by Hockey Australia and adopted by Hockey Queensland.
- Do not bet on the outcome or on any other aspect of a hockey match or competition.
- Do not try to achieve a contrived outcome to a match or competition, or otherwise improperly influence the outcome or any other aspect of a match or a competition.
- Do not show unnecessary obvious dissension, displeasure or disapproval (by action or verbal abuse) towards an umpire or match official as a consequence of his or her decision or generally.
- Abstain from the use of tobacco and the consumption of alcoholic beverages while in the playing/representative uniform.
- Adhere to Hockey Australia's racial and sexual vilification policy which has been adopted by Hockey Queensland.
- Don't do anything which adversely affects or reflects on or discredits the game of hockey, Hockey Australia, Hockey Queensland, any HQ Association, or any squad, team, competition, tournament, sponsor, official supplier or licensee, including, but not limited to, any illegal act or any act of dishonesty or fraud.
- Refrain from using obscene, offensive or insulting language and/or making obscene gestures which may insult other players, officials or spectators.

# TURF RULES

## **Burringbar Park Artificial Surface Terms of Entry**

1. The following items are prohibited on the turf:
  - No Glass including Glass drinking bottles or cans
  - All drinks other than water/sports drinks in plastic or non-fracturable containers
  - Chewing gum or lollies
  - All foodstuffs
  - Hard plastic soled shoes or boots with either cleats or sprigs. Boots / Shoes with leather or metal screw in sprigs
  - Cigarettes, cigars, lighters, matches and pipes
  - High heeled or Stiletto shoes
  - Bobby Pins
2. Spitting on the surface is not permitted.
3. All balls, domes etc. shall be clean of all foreign matter before being used on the artificial surface.
4. Goalkeepers are not permitted to mark the artificial surface in any way as may be marked on natural grass surfaces.
5. Hard protective guards for knees and elbows are not permitted.
6. All footwear must be cleaned of exterior rubbish (stones, dirt, mud, grass etc.) before entry to the surface. Players or officials on the artificial surface are not permitted to wear footwear with leather or metal sprigs, screw-in plastic sprigs or moulded rubber/plastic sprigs of less than 15 per boot. Goalkeepers may wear boots with moulded rubber sprigs or moulded plastic sprigs provided they are trimmed down to protrude no more than 7mm from the sole and are ground to a smooth dome so that no sharp edges damage the turf. No other type of sprig is permissible. All toe caps are to be taped.

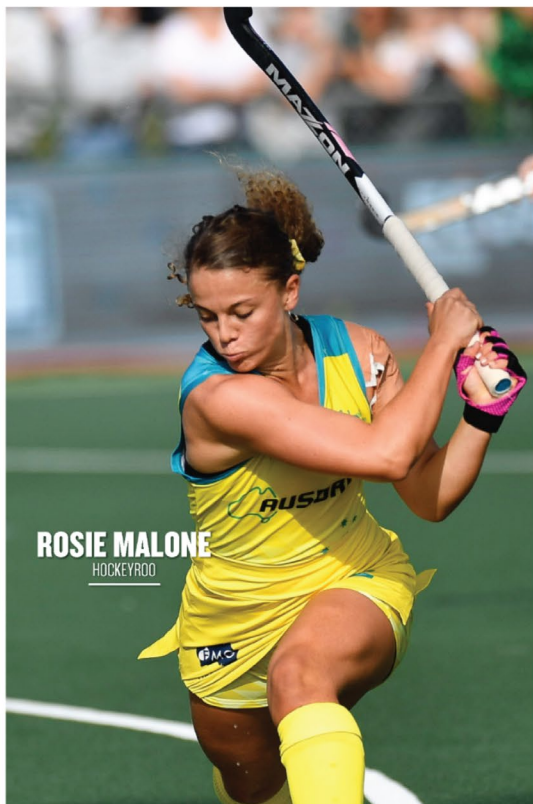

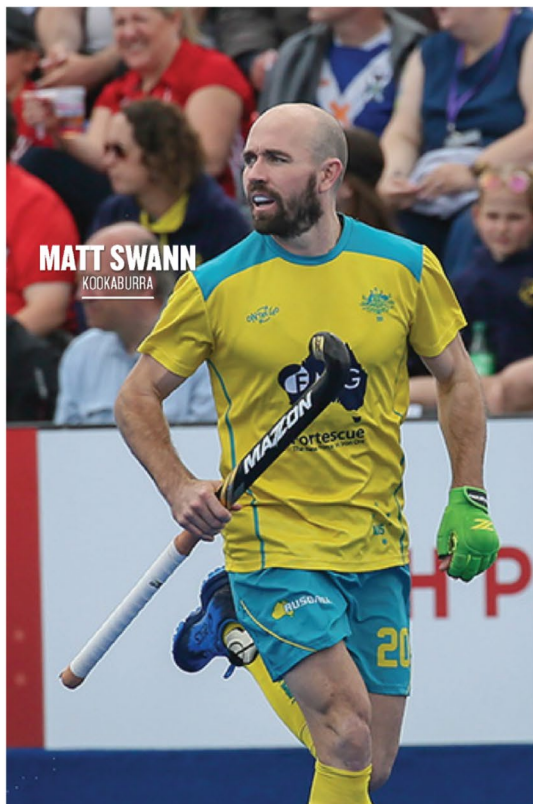
