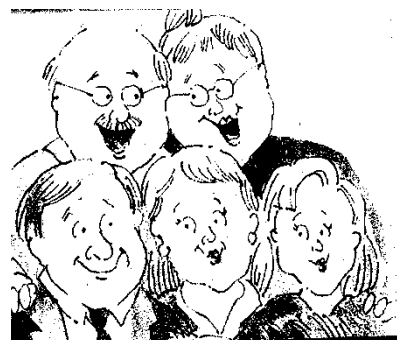

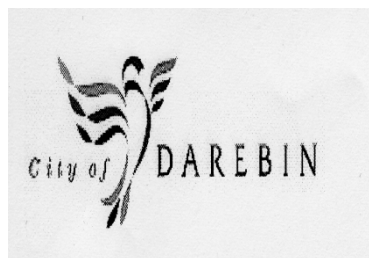
The engineer sits up straight and says, “Wow! Are you kidding?”
