# **Technical Information**

### **Timetable**

The Final Timetable has been released and is available on the ANSW website <a href="here">here</a>. Please note, there have been changes from the draft. Athletes MUST check this timetable to confirm the start time of their event/s.

# **Entry Lists**

Entry lists are available from the ANSW website - <a href="www.nswathletics.org.au">www.nswathletics.org.au</a>. It is essential that all athletes check this list to confirm their entry into the competition. If you have any concerns, please contact the ANSW office at your earliest convenience.

## Athlete Check In / Bib Number

Athletes will be issued with their official competition bib when they collect their accreditation at the front gate.

All **TRACK** athletes **must report** to **Athlete Check-in** to advise of their intention to compete **at least sixty (60) minutes** before the scheduled starting time of their first event each day. Failure to check-in may result in the athlete being scratched from the event. **Athlete check-in will be in VIP Room 2,** on the concourse.

Once checked in, track athletes must report to the start area of the event at least 10 minutes before the scheduled starting time.

**Field athletes do not need to attend Athlete Check in**. Once you have entered the venue, please report to the field site at least 20 minutes before so warm ups can be completed.

# Warm Up Track

The Warm Up Track will be open for the duration of the competition. There will be no Warm Up permitted on main arena, with the exception of the allocated time provided to athletes directly prior to field events.

# Venue

The NSW All Schools will take place at the Sydney Olympic Park Athletic Centre, Edwin Flack Ave, Sydney Olympic Park.

Venue Entry will be via the Main entry on the corner of Edwin Flack and Dawn Fraser.

# **Getting to the Venue**

Parking is available in one of the Sydney Olympic Park parking stations. ANSW suggests P1 or P2 which are the closet to the front gate of the Athletic Centre. See this indirective map for more information

Parking tickets can be validated at the Athletics Centre Reception area for 4 hours free parking.

The venue can also be accessed via public transport. Bus number 525 (Parramatta to Strathfield) and 526 (Burwood to Rhodes) services drop on Dawn Fraser Avenue, right outside the main entrance to the Athletic Centre.

The closest train station is Sydney Olympic park which is approximately 750m to the Athletic Centre.

### Ticketing

The NSW All Schools provides a direct qualification window to the Australian All Schools held in Adelaide from the 9-11<sup>th</sup> of December. Please read the selection policy carefully here.
