For registering a participant who is under the age of 18 years

- Any runner under the age of 18 as of the start date of an event through Active **cannot register themselves**
- Any runner under the age of 18 needs to be entered **via an Active profile of someone over the age of 18**, who chooses the "Someone else, below 18" option from the dropdown menu on the registration page when registering the U/18 runner (image above)
- If this person over the age of 18 does not have an Active registration profile, they will need to create one through the following Active "Passport" link, and then use their details to register the runner under the age of 18 years for all future Active events.
