



Finding Somewhere To Play Pickleball In NSW

To find a pickleball venue in NSW please go to the Pickleball Association of NSW's website places to play page.

When you find a venue near you, please contact the venue host directly to confirm the session and your level of play (beginner, experienced or advanced).

You must book in advance to attend a pickleball session. Each venue has its own booking system.

Once you are a member of our Meetup Group you will see all the scheduled pickleball sessions. You must RSVP to reserve your spot before attending a venue. Make sure you read the details to obtain all the information for your chosen venue. Bring water and wear shoes suitable for on court play.

Some venues provide free paddle hire but other venues require players to bring their own paddles - check with the venue. Paddles are available for sale online with several local suppliers offering free trials. Basic paddles cost about \$50.
