

# **2024 EVENT REQUIREMENTS**

## PR Women's and Men's Interstate Scull Masters Selection

DATE: 22 December 2023

REFERENCE: Event Requirements – PR3 Women's and Men's Interstate Scull Masters Selection

EVENT: 2024 Interstate Regatta – Australian Masters Rowing Championships

This document should be read together with the <u>Rowing New South Wales Selection Policy</u> dated 18 September 2023 in particular Section 8, Selection Criteria and the Rowing Australia rules governing eligibility for athletes competing in Interstate events at the Australia Masters Rowing Championships (AMRC).

The handicaps to be used in this event will be the standard Rowing Australia Masters handicaps. The event has been designated as a PR3 event. PR2 or PR1 athletes, if successful in the trial race will be able to compete in the event as PR3 athletes. PR2 or PR1 athletes will not receive a classification handicap.

#### 1. NOMINATIONS

Participants must nominate for selection. The completed nomination form should be completed via the online nomination form 5.00pm Friday 2 February 2024 via Nomination forms.

Athletes wishing to nominate do not need to be formally classified. Provisional classification can be used for those that have not been through the formal process.

#### 2. STATE TEAM SELECTION ACTIVITIES

All athletes must have nominated in accordance with section 1 (Nominations) and must complete the activities listed below:

a. 2024 Sydney Rowing Club Regatta – Saturday 24 February 2023. Athletes must compete in a Para women's or men's 1000 metre single scull event.

#### 3. FINAL SELECTION

Participants will be ranked according to the results of the 2024 Sydney Rowing Club Regatta. Scullers will be ranked by their actual race time over the race distance excluding any handicap. The male and female athlete with the fastest net time will be selected as the scullers to contest the Men's and Women's Para Interstate scull events at the AMRC.



### 4. STATE TEAM ELIGIBILITY

All nominees must be:

- (a) A current registered member of Rowing NSW;
- (b) A current financial member of a rowing club affiliated with Rowing NSW;
- (c) Be provisionally classified at a minimum
- (d) be competent scullers with previous racing experience
- (e) Able to demonstrate adherence to the Rowing NSW Code of Conduct;
- (f) Be a NSW resident for the purpose of their eligibility to represent NSW;
- (g) Be willing and able to travel to and compete in the AMRC regatta at their own cost.

#### 5. CODE OF CONDUCT

All selected participants are required to sign and adhere to the Rowing NSW <u>2024 State Team Participant</u> Agreement.
