

2024 EVENT REQUIREMENTS

Women's and Men's Interstate Scull

DATE: 28 September 2023

REFERENCE: Event Requirements –Women's and Men's Interstate Scull

EVENT: 2024 Kings and Queens Cup Interstate Regatta

This document should be read together with the <u>Rowing New South Wales Selection Policy</u> and the Rowing Australia rules governing eligibility for athletes competing in the Interstate Regatta.

1. NOMINATIONS

Participants must nominate for selection. The completed nomination form should be lodged with Rowing NSW by **5:00 PM on Friday 8th January 2023** via Nomination Forms.

A club may submit a nomination on behalf of a Participant in which case the Participant must confirm their nomination in writing if requested to do so by the Selectors or otherwise prior to final team selection.

2. STATE TEAM SELECTION ACTIVITIES

All athletes must have nominated in accordance with section 1 (Nominations) and must complete the activities listed below:

- 2.1 2000 metre ergometer test conducted between 1st December 2023 and 27th January 2024. Result to be submitted to <u>state.team@rowingnsw.asn.au</u> at the Rowing NSW Office by 5:00 PM 28th January 2024.
- 2.2 2024 Rowing NSW State Championships Regatta Friday 9th February to Sunday 11th February 2024, SIRC, Penrith.
 Athletes must compete in a women's or men's 2000 metre championship single scull event.
- 2.3 2000 metre on water racing as conducted under the Rowing Australia National selection event supplement. Results of the National Selection Trials will be the primary criteria of assessment for selection.
 - Athletes that have not nominated for National Team Selection will be assessed on the remaining state team selection activities.



3. EXEMPTIONS

Athletes seeking exemption from Compulsory Selection Activities must do so in writing to the CEO of Rowing NSW at least 48 hours prior to the affected Selection Activity stating the reasons why exemption is sought, or by lodging a medical certificate within 48 hours following the Selection Activity. All exemptions must be signed (or endorsed) by the affected participant and their club coach or an officer of the club that the participant is representing. Selectors may request participants who receive an exemption to undertake other Compulsory Selection Activities at a later date and/or provide additional performance data or race results.

If a Participant is unable to complete sufficient Selection Activities due to an injury, illness or other matters outside of their control selectors at their sole discretion, may exclude them from consideration for selection in the crew.

4. FINAL CREW SELECTION

Participants will be ranked according to the results of the Rowing NSW Championship Regatta, national selection trials and ergometer results. The scullers to contest the Men's and Women's events at the Interstate Regatta will be the highest ranked NSW scullers available to contest those events having regard to other commitments athletes may have to the NSW interstate team.

5. RACING AT THE INTERSTATE REGATTA

Selected crew athletes (excluding reserves) may not compete in any club or school events on the same day as the Interstate Regatta.
