### **Application Instructions**

#### *Club/School Applicants*

1. Please complete Part 1 and Part 2 of the application on the following pages.
2. Please complete all areas of the application. Failure to complete these will indicate an incomplete application and may not be processed.
3. Uniform diagrams must accompany this application. Failure to provide details may result in this application not being processed.
4. Diagrams may be submitted as JPG files by email.
5. Please also submit a copy of your club's constitution (school's not required).

#### *Association Applicants*

1. Please complete Part 1 only.

### **Application Process**

After submitting this application, your details will be recorded into all RV data bases with the application being forwarded to the RV Board for acceptance. These details will then be forwarded to the RV Finance officer to issue an invoice for your fees. Once the fees are paid, you are then considered an affiliated member of Rowing Victoria.

**Please note:** when selecting colours and designs for uniform, consideration must be given to the upper part of the uniform, as strong similarities between uniforms will not be approved. Download the Club and School Uniform Lists off the "About" / "Rules & Policies" section of the RV website for current diagrams of uniforms.

### **Membership Fees**

Two forms of membership fees exist:

1. A Club, School, Association fee.
  2. Affiliation fee for each individual.
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1. The Club and School Affiliation fee begins at \$425.00 Inc GST per annum and is adjusted according to the number of competitive members within the Club. Your membership application is processed at the next monthly Rowing Victoria (RV) Board meeting. Once approved, your club will be invoiced for this amount. Thereafter, you will be invoiced for your delegate fee on July 1<sup>st</sup> each year. Rowing Victoria's RV Constitution and Rules are available on our website and should be read thoroughly as many rules of racing and administrative requirements are explained.

### Club/School Uniform Application

#### Process

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The following document outlines the process for clubs/schools to register their uniform and racing colours with Rowing Victoria (RV).

Applicants are to outline their proposed design on the following page including colours, emblems/logos and trimmings.

Applications are then to be sent to Rowing Victoria for review with the Umpires Committee and RV Board.

Unsuccessful applications will be returned along with reasons stating why the application wasn't approved and suggested modifications.

Successful applications will be notified directly by RV in writing.

There can be no phase in period for a uniform change.

#### Guidelines

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The following guidelines have been put in place to provide guidance to clubs and schools wishing to change their current uniform, or for newly created clubs to design a uniform.

Currently we have 92 clubs and schools and there are many similar uniforms. These similarities provide difficulties for umpires and judges when looking at crews from a distance, often at odd angles and often dealing with environmental issues such as sun glare.

Please take into account the following:

- Consider colours which are different or unusual – light green, light blue, red, orange, yellow, pink.
- Consider options to break up large blocks of colour – stripes - horizontal, vertical, or diagonal can assist in distinguishing uniforms.
- Triangular blocks of colour contrasting with the rest of the uniform.
- Other unusual shapes and designs can be used (circles, swirls, zig zags).
- Text and logos on the back of the uniform.
- Dark block colours can no longer be accepted.

A register of current uniform designs is available on the Rowing Victoria website. Clubs and schools should check this to ensure there is no direct clash.

Assistance with designing uniforms can be provided by your zoot suit manufacturer.

The uniform committee will respond to your initial request within 2 weeks of initial contact.

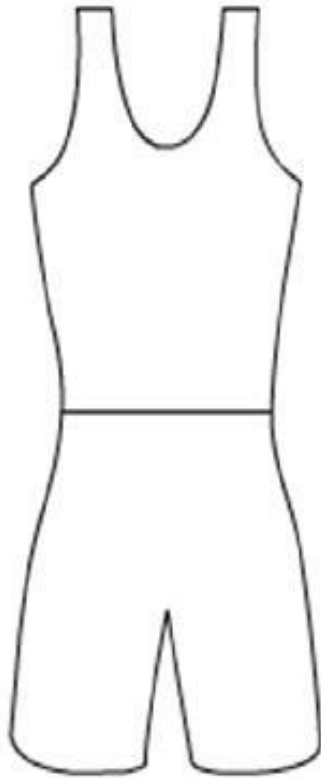

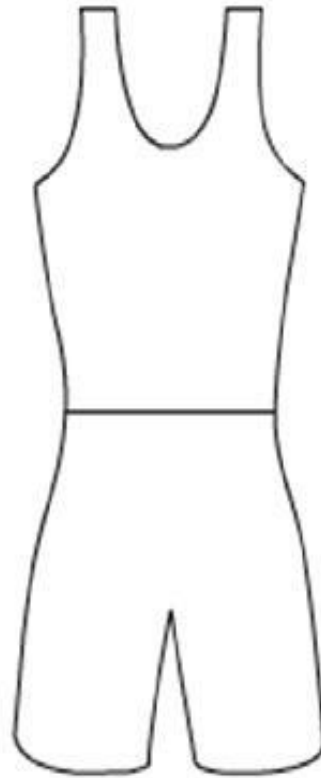
