PHASE 4

From 27 June 2020

FULL TRAINING AND COMPETITION

- Maintain a minimum of 2sqm per person
- Full return to competition and training
- All previous gathering restrictions removed
- All equipment to be cleaned with soap/ water or antibacterial wipes between use
- All club facilities can open including toilets, showers, kitchens and clubrooms if cleaned regularly
- Gyms can operate unstaffed, with regular cleaning maintained
- Facility-based COVID Safety Plan still required
- No requirement to maintain Contact Register
- Continue to minimise unnecessary contact and shared equipment where possible

Lockdown 2.0 – Boatsheds Closed

Lockdown Transition

From 6pm 5 February 2021

- A mask must be worn by rowers at all times unless conducting outdoor vigorous exercise
- Masks must be worn at all times when exercising indoors, no exceptions
- Coaches must wear masks at all times, no exceptions
- Boatsheds need to revise their capacity to meet the 4 square metre rule
- There is a 150 person capacity for fitness venues, public venues and community sport.
- Contact Registers are mandatory at all rowing clubs.
- Masks are not compulsory for primary aged youth.
- Boatsheds should continue to maintain regular cleaning protocols, social distancing where possible and encourage good personal hygiene
- Clubs and schools should maintain policies requiring members with symptoms to stay away from the boatshed and get COVID tested
- Boatsheds must maintain their COVID safety plans.

PHASE 4

From 14 February 2021

FULL TRAINING AND COMPETITION

- Maintain a minimum of 2sqm per person
- Full return to competition and training
- All previous gathering restrictions removed
- All equipment to be cleaned with soap/ water or antibacterial wipes between use
- All club facilities can open including toilets, showers, kitchens and clubrooms if cleaned regularly
