PHASE 3

6 June 2020

CREW BOATS AND LIMITED COMPETITIONS

- A maximum of 100 people per undivided space, up to 300 patrons per venue (excluding staff and coaches)
- Maintain a strict minimum of 2sqm per person and 1.5m between people on land
- All crew boats are now permitted (including coxed boats). Coxswains may opt to wear face protection
- All equipment can be shared but must be cleaned with soap/water or antibacterial wipes/sprays between use
- Venue/Facility COVID Safety Plans to be updated prior to moving to Phase 3 operations
- Toilets, showers and change rooms can be used if cleaned
- Rowing gyms can open with all equipment utilised (if staffed during use).
- Club-based function rooms can re-open in line with restrictions

PHASE 4

27 June 2020

FULL TRAINING AND COMPETITION

- Maintain a minimum of 2sqm per person
- Full return to competition and training
- All previous gathering restrictions removed
- All equipment to be cleaned with soap/ water or antibacterial wipes between use
- All club facilities can open including toilets, showers, kitchens and clubrooms if cleaned regularly
- Gyms can operate unstaffed, with regular cleaning maintained
- Facility-based COVID Safety Plan still required
- No requirement to maintain Contact Register
- Continue to minimise unnecessary contact and shared equipment where possible

PHASE 5*

Tentative: 24 October 2020

BACK TO NORMAL IN WA

All restrictions to be lifted related to the operation of rowing sheds and rowing competitions within WA including the removal of the 2sqm rule

- Don't row if showing symptoms of COVID-19

PHASE 6*

Date to be advised

BACK TO NORMAL IN AUSTRALIA

West Australians will be able to travel freely within Australia without having to quarantine upon return

- Don't row if showing symptoms of COVID-19
