

HOBART SCHOOLS TEAM SAILING SERIES 2023 Term 1

NOTICE OF RACE (NOR)

**Organising Authority:
Sandy Bay Sailing Club in conjunction
with Australian Sailing**

1 Rules

The series will be governed by the current rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing, the special regulations of Australian Sailing, the Team Racing Rules (Appendix D), (except as any of these are altered by the sailing instructions) and by the sailing instructions.

2 Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1 All competitors are required to be members of an AS affiliated Club in accordance with RRS 46. Event membership is available from Sandy Bay Sailing Club. Those requiring a temporary membership shall email admin@sandybaysailingclub.org.au to arrange.
- 2.2 Entry is open to teams of at least 6 people representing a school or club, subject to the following:
- (a) If a school entry, each team member must be a student, parent of a student, teacher or staff member of the school they represent.
 - (b) If a club entry, each team member must be a financial member of the club they represent and under the age of 19 at 31st December 2023, unless otherwise granted by the organising authority.
 - (c) If a school or club does not have sufficient sailors to make up a team, it may combine with another school or club at the discretion of the organising authority.
 - (d) Each school will be allocated a date to provide a volunteer for Race Officer Assist.
- 2.3 Eligible teams may enter via the [online entry form](#). Entries must be lodged by the following date:

2023 Term 1 Series: 7pm Wednesday, February 15th 2023

- 2.4 The Organising Authority reserves the right to limit the number of teams entered by each school or club.
- 2.5 Each school team manager will be responsible for obtaining the consent of the competitors' parent or guardian to participate in the event subject to the rules, hold and have accessible any relevant information about medical conditions and hold appropriate emergency contact details.

- 2.6 **Cost of damage and/or insurance excess incurred during the series will be directly invoiced to the school/s responsible for the damage.** If damages cannot be attributed to a specific team, the cost will be split evenly amongst all teams and invoiced to all schools.

3 Fees

- 3.1 The entry fees (including GST) are the following:

The entry fee is a non-refundable fee and will be paid at the time of entry.

- 3.2 In the circumstance that additional costs are required to run the event due to COVID-19, these costs will be split evenly and passed forward to all schools.

- 4.3 All divisions will race on Wednesday evenings if the total number of entries are not more than 13 teams.

5 Boats

- 5.1 The series will be sailed in team sailing dinghies as supplied by the Organising Authority.
- 5.2 Damage, see 2.6
- 5.3 **Bailers will not be supplied** by the organising authority and are the responsibility of the schools.

6 Sailing Instructions

Sailing instructions including the series roster will be posted on the official website [here](#).

7 Racing Area

The racing area will be the Derwent River in the immediate vicinity of the Sandy Bay Sailing Club.

8 Courses

Courses will be as described in the Sailing Instructions and of a length suitable to be sailed in approximately 6 -10 minutes.

9 Scoring

9.1 Races will be scored in accordance with App D3.

9.2 Each heat will comprise three races where time and conditions permit. One point will be allocated to the winner of each race if three races are sailed. If two races are sailed, 1.5 points will be allocated to the winner of each race, and if only one race is sailed, the winner will receive 3 points. If no races are sailed, each team will receive 1.5 points. The winner of each division will be the team with the most points. Ties will be decided in accordance with D4.3.

10 Umpires

Races will be umpired in accordance with App D2.2.

12 Media Rights

By participating in this event competitors automatically grant to the Organising Authority, and their sponsors, the right in perpetuity to make, use and show, from time to time at their discretion, any motion pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of the athlete during the period of the competition without compensation.

13 Disclaimer of Liability

Competitors participate in the regattas entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to race. The organising authority shall not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta
