

Registering for Races

There are a number of ways race RSVPs can be handled on the new platform. For this first season, I am trying a method that doesn't clutter the calendar with duplicate entries (one event for Survivor and one for Club), and also captures whether people want to race all of the things, or prefer to be on only one crew. This being our first season on the new platform, please be patient if processes need to be altered due to some unforeseen consequence.

Here are some notes to help you with your first race registration. Be sure you are logged in.

For ease of finding the races, you can filter the calendar on the website. The website defaults to the calendar view, but you can change it to list view by clicking List in the left pane. By clicking Races under Category and then Search, you will see a list of only the races that are on our calendar.

You can click the name of the race to see more details, or you can go straight to Register. Consider right-click and opening a new tab if you are RSVPing for multiple races, as this can save you time and clicking.

Once you've clicked Register, here are the steps to sign up.

1. The system knows all of your details because you are logged in.
2. Under Additional Information, fill in a comment if needed, especially if yours is a Maybe or a No RSVP.
3. Under Select Tickets, choose one of each ticket that applies to your registration.
 - You can select as many tickets as you are willing and qualified to race. For instance, a woman might select the SAKE Women's Crew, the SAKE Mixed Crew, or both.
 - Larger events might also have tickets for Masters or Grandmasters in both Mixed and Women
 - Choose Not Attending for No RSVPs
 - Choose Undecided for Maybe RSVPs
 - Note that it is as important to know who can't come or who is on the fence as it is to know who will be there. This helps to focus recruiting efforts to fill rosters if needed.
 - RSVP as early as you can so that we don't miss out on racing opportunities filling up.
4. Tick the box that says you are over 18 blah blah.
5. On the resulting screen, check your details and Confirm. It is possible to go back a screen in your browser and correct things if needed.

Note: Because of the way that ticketing works, you cannot change your RSVPs as you can for practice. However, you can register more than once for races. If you find later that you want to change your RSVP, just make a new registration, and the race registration manager will go on the details given in the date of your most recent registration, and delete duplicates. Be sure each registration reflects your intent at the time of your registration. For instance, if you register thinking you only want to be on the Women's crew, but then later decide you'd also like to race Mixed, put a new registration through for both. The first one for just the Women's crew will then be deleted.

Pro Tip: When you are viewing the event, and you click Who's Going, you can filter to see who is RSVP'd for what crew through the drop-down at the top of the resulting window.
