One of SA's finest, Pedro De Mello Machado, explained: "We are drawn into a very tough and experienced Team Sailing group of countries and are excited to be part of this league to battle it out against the world's best eSailors, have fun and make new friends

"As eTeam Sailing is new to RSA we held two pre-tournament practice sessions with teams from the UAE and Spain to gain valuable experience and test the Discord communication platform which is paramount in any eTeam event.
