

Team Sailing League – Western Cape

Western Cape SAS Team Sailing
League boats in September
2020, a convoy of odd bakkies
and multiple trailers setting out
to liberate the seven boats from
Imperial Yacht Club. The boats
will be based at MAC until the
end of August 2023.

As with all other activities, Covid-19 has been responsible for the usual disruptions to team sailing at MAC, but the club has been running monthly team racing events when lockdowns, summer holidays and howling South-easters have permitted. To date, three events have been held, with very enthusiastic support from the RCYC Academy, the MAC juniors, HBYC Academy, Cape Peninsula University of Technology, and the University of Cape Town.

The most recent event featured no fewer than

six teams, with the final contested between
Team Hall, consisting mostly of Zeekoeivlei
sailors, and the dark horse entry from the
Cape Peninsula University of Technology.
The highly experienced Team Hall
ultimately prevailed, but the CPUT
performance was a very welcome surprise.

Hosting team racing events has brought new energy to the racing scene at MAC and provided an incentive for developing a deeper understanding of the racing rules. A
