Tricia Sibraa umpired at her first national event in 1984 at the National Club Championships held in Brisbane. She achieved her Level 6 Umpiring Accreditation in 1989 at the Open Men's National Championship and the following year received her ISF Umpiring Accreditation.

Tricia served on the National Umpiring Committee from 1992 until 2007. In 2001 she became Deputy Umpire in Chief and eventually the Umpire in Chief in 2009, a position she held until 2017.



In 2003, Tricia developed material for competency-based assessment of umpires for the Australian Sports Commission.

Between 1984 and 2015 she umpired at 26 national championships, attending two as Deputy Umpire-in-Chief and 19 as Chief Umpire at national championships and international events.
