

Pat Shearwood (née Stuckey) (ACT) Open Women's Statistician # 4 Softball Australia umpire # AA41 92 games for Australia

As well as being the Statistician for the Open Women's team over a period of 12 years, Pat Shearwood achieved her Level 6 umpiring accreditation in 1971 and was also heavily involved as an administrator.

She was the ACT delegate to the ASF and in 1974 Pat took over the role as Treasurer for the national body.



With a background in bookkeeping and business management, she took on the arduous task of overhauling the financial systems of the organisation. She introduced a savings program with an expenditure budget that included forward estimates for four years in preparation for the next World Championship.

Pat found herself playing devil's advocate to ensure that plans were examined for their financial implications. Her analytic mind and forthright manner gave her the confidence to make decisions.
