

NOMINATION INFORMATION SHEET

In 2024, the **Sports Foyer Community Sport Awards** will be once again a feature of the Sport NSW event calendar.

Sport NSW host two awards ceremonies each year, the **Sport Foyer Community Sports Awards** in June and the **rebel NSW Sports Awards** (rebel Champions of Sport) in November.

Although both award programs have similar award categories, the **Sport Foyer Community Sports Awards** is intended to recognise the large volunteer workforce and community clubs and teams, recognising their outstanding achievements and contributions to community sport in NSW.

The **rebel NSW Sports Award** that are presented at the Champions of Sport Ceremony in November are aimed at recognising the achievement of our professional Coaches, Administrators, Officials and Organisations along with high performance athletes within the NSW sports industry.

We encourage all sporting organisations to consider their community volunteers, clubs and teams to be nominated within the categories of the **Sports Foyer Community Sports Awards**.

Key points

Refer to the following key points along with the **2024 Sports Foyer NSW Community Sport Award Guidelines** prior to submitting a nomination:

- If you wish to submit a nomination, please ensure the nomination has been endorsed by the relevant Sport NSW member organisation, such as, State Sporting Organisation, State Sporting Organisation with a Disability, regional not-for-profit organisations such as Regional Academies of Sport or Associate Members of Sport NSW (ie. Local Councils).
- Only one nomination per award category can be lodged by each Sport NSW member organisation. If more than one nomination is received, the Sport NSW Member Organisation will be contacted to determine which nomination they wish to be included in the category.
- Nominations are assessed based on the information provided. All fields have a 200-word limit, here are some tips to consider when completing your nomination.
 - Include the facts only, nominations cannot be assessed on what may have been, or what may be.
 - When using acronyms to reference competitions or level of achievements, please ensure that the judges will understand what they refer to.
 - Provide achievements in the order of merit, this will assist the judges to clearly outline the achievements in the period.
 - Only outline achievements within the nomination period (1 May 2023 – 30 April 2024) nominations can only be judged on achievements in this period.
 - Make sure you complete /answer every question /criteria of the category.
 - Images as requested (one portrait/team image and one action image) as a part of the nomination, must be provided at the time of submission. Images may be used in promotional material pre and post event, please ensure all persons in the images have approved their use.
- Nominations are for achievements / contributions from 1 May 2023 to 30 April 2024.
