



Catcher tries to pick off a runner on first base, the throw hits runner on the helmet and the ball deflects away from the fielders, runner runs to second base and is safe.


How would you record the plays?

- 2. **2-E3** first base was not in front of the base for the catcher to throw for the out.



Sacrifice Bunts

The National Scoring Committee is now adopting the definition of a sacrifice bunt as per WBSC.

No sacrifice is awarded if the bunt leads to a runner being put out, even if one or more runners advance.

For further information in relation to sacrifice bunts and various scenarios, please refer to section 9.1 Sacrifice Bunt of the Level 2 scoring manual.

Sacrifice Flies

Points of note:

- There must be less than two out
- The runner must score
- If the fly is muffed it is still a sacrifice if, in the scorer's opinion, the run would have scored had the fly ball been taken. Exception; where the base runner scores from 2nd base

For further information in relation to sacrifice flies and various scenarios, please refer to section 9.2 Sacrifice fly of the Level 2 scoring manual.
