November Scenario Challenge -

Challenge 1

Italy v Venezuela game (2018 WBSC Women's World Champs)

Note, it isn't a bunt but a mis-hit. The ball starts out in foul territory and rolls back into fair territory. There is a replay following the play.

1st base bobbles the ball in trying to pick it up but recovers enough to throw the ball to second base covering first. The ball arrives at just about the same time as the batter-runner.

How would you record the play?

E3 in 1st base box, WT3 in 2nd base box and a red link line between the two.

Challenge 2

For Level 2 and above -

How would you score earned and unearned runs for the three runs scored?

Things to look for in considering earned and unearned runs are errors, PBs and tie break runners. In the example, there are no errors and no tie break runners, only one PB. When reconstructing without the PB, when B3 swung at the 3rd pitch, B2 would have been on 1st base making B3 out on dropped third strike rule so B3's run is unearned and B3 would have been the second out. B2 would have advanced to 2nd on the WP and

then scored from 2nd on B4's double, so B2s run is earned. B4 scored from 2nd on B5s hit to 9. There would still have only been 2 out so B4's run is earned.

February Scenario Challenge -

B2 hits a 3 base hit to left field. B3 hit a grounder to 3rd base field. The 3rd base fielder does not make a play at 1st base on the batter but hold the ball to stop B2 at 3rd base from scoring.

B4 receive a pitched strike, B3 precedes to 2nd base, the catcher throws the ball to shortstop (no attempt to get the out), B2 takes off for home on the throw, shortstop throws to catcher for the tag out at home. B3 continues to 3rd base. The catcher throws to 3rd base fielder for the tag out.

How would you record the play?

Updates on Scoring Levels Requirements

CHANGES TO LEVEL 2 REQUIREMENTS
"A recent review of the Level 2 manual
and lecture material conducted by the SQ
Scoring Committee (SQSC) has revealed
some changes which may have escaped
notice of lecturers and Level 2 candidates.
These are:

- Extension of Put Outs, Assists and Errors to the top of the page belong in Level 3. The PO, A, E area has been removed from the top of the Level 2 Exam Score Sheets – no longer required in Level 2.
- Counting the Strikes, Balls and Fouls for each innings at the bottom of the score sheet also belong in Level 3. The S, B, F area has been removed from the bottom of the Level 2 Exam Score Sheets – no longer required in Level 2.
- In Level 2, the name and position of the DP are written in Green. No other green annotation is required for the DP. The purpose of keeping the DP in green in the line-up is to minimise the possibility of having the Flex bat for any player other than the DP.

Recent decisions by the National Scoring Committee (NSC) and State Directors have also impacted on Level 2.

- Batting Out of Order will now receive major attention in Level 2 lecturers.
 Handling it correctly is now expected of Level 2 scorers.
- Caught Stealing(CS) and Pick Off (PK) symbols are not required in Level 2 but are part of Level 3.
- Sacrifice Hits and Sacrifice Flies remain part of Level 2.
- The timing of changes will ALWAYS be indicated in the format Innings/Batter No – for example – T6/5

NSC is working on a new Level 2 manual to reflect all these changes.
