May Scenario Challenge –

Thank you, Gayle Ray from Redcliffe, for this scenario. She asks how you would score it – Runner on 3rd base.

Batter had a dropped 3rd strike.

Catcher threw to 3rd to try and get the runner out, but he got back to base safe.

3rd base player threw to 1st base and got the batter/runner out.

On the throw from 3rd to 1st base the runner on 3rd ran home safely.

Answer -

For the example – the Runner is B3 and Batter Runner is B4 -

B4 is out - K2-5-3

Depending on scorer's interpretation, B3 is safe at home with either 4 or \$4.

My preference is for \$4 as B3 was always going to steal home if possible. B4 had a K and would not have advanced B4. B3 should get the credit of advancing home with a steal eg \$4.

July Scenario Challenge -

Scenario 1 -

2 out. B1 hits a hard ground ball to Right Field and is safe on 1st base. B2 hits a hard ground ball to Centre Field B1 advances to 2nd base and B2 is safe on 1st base. B3 hits a pop fly over shortstop which is picked up by Left Field – B1 was safe on 3rd base, B2 was safe on 2nd base and B3 was safe on 1st base. B4 hits an over the fence home run. All runners run home. B2 missed 3rd base when running home. The fielding team throw the ball to 3rd base and

appeal the out on B2 missing the base. The out is given.

How would you record the plays?

Scenario 2 -

1 out. B1 hits a hard ground ball to Right Field and is safe on 1st base. B2 hits a hard ground ball to Centre Field B1 advances to 2nd base and B2 is safe on 1st base. B3 hits a pop fly over shortstop which is picked up by Left Field – B1 was safe on 3rd base, B2 was safe on 2nd base and B3 was safe on 1st base. B4 hits an over the fence home run. All runners run home. B2 missed 3rd base when running home. The fielding team throw the ball to 3rd base and appeal the out on B2 missing the base. The out is given.
