

February Challenge

Score the earned and unearned runs and ream solution.



Reconstruction of play without errors would result in the following:

1st Out B4 out on a F9

2nd Out B6 as play would be to 1st base as B4 is out and not on base to run – Red. This gives the benefit of the doubt to the Pitcher which is

fundamental in the assessment of earned and unearned runs.

B5 is Green as advanced by B7 single hit before the 3rd out.

3rd Out B7 at third base (PB is an "error" for these considerations, therefore all runs following are Red.

May Challenge

Scenario 1:

B2 is on 2nd, B3 receives a called strike, B2 takes off for 3rd, Catcher throws to 3rd base, B2 heads back to 2nd, 3rd base throws to 2nd base, B2 heads back to 3rd, 2nd base throws to shortstop who tags B2 out.
How would you record the play?

Scenario 2:

B2 is on 2nd, B3 receives a called strike, B2 takes off for 3rd, Catcher throws to 3rd base, B2 heads back to 2nd, 3rd base throws to 2nd base, B2 heads back to 3rd, 2nd base throws to shortstop who errors the receiving of the throw, B2 is safe on 3rd.

How would you record the play?

Scenario 3:

B2 is on 2nd, B3 receives a called strike, B2 takes off for 3rd, Catcher throws to 3rd base, B2 heads back to 2nd, 3rd base throws to 2nd base, B2 heads back to 3rd, 2nd base throws to shortstop but B2 was too quick and was safe on 3rd.

How would you record the play?
