November Challenge -

The Scenario 1 case:

Bottom 7 – Score is Tied – None out. B1 hits a safe 2 base hit. B2 hits a fly to Centre Field which is dropped. B1 scores the winning run on the error. Game ends.

Which colour would you use for B1 run? Red or Green?

Answer: Green Run

My interpretation: The pitcher allows the B1 safe hit. As the game has ended there is no determining factor that could turn it into a red run.

The Scenario 2 case:

Bottom 7 – Score is Tied – 1 out. B1 hits a safe 2 base hit. B2 hits a fly to Centre Field which is dropped. B1 scores the winning run on the error. Game ends.

Which colour would you use for B1 run? Red or Green?

Answer: Green Run

My interpretation: The pitcher allows the B1 safe hit. As the game has ended there is no determining factor that could turn it into a red run.

The Scenario 3 case:

Bottom 7 – Score is Tied – 2 out. B1 hits a safe 2 base hit. B2 hits a fly to Centre Field which is dropped. B1 scores the winning run on the error. Game ends.

Which colour would you use for B1 run? Red or Green?

Answer: Red Run

My interpretation: The pitcher allows the B1 safe hit. As the game has ended by the error and the run scoring on the error. If the B2 Fly was caught – no run is scored - end of inning go to top of 8th inning.

February Challenge –

The Scenario case:

(Thanks to Cheryl Green for the scenario.)
Bases loaded. Two out. Full count on the batter.
Wild pitch comes down & goes over the
catchers' head into the back net.
Batter/runner trots off to 1s base. All runners
advance. Runner from 3rd trots down the line,
steps over home plate & proceeds to walk off.
Pitcher runs down to home plate & calls for the
ball. Catcher tosses pitcher the ball; pitcher
stands on home plate & makes the appeal.
How would you record the out?
