July Scenario Challenge –

Team A & B are one all at the bottom of the 7th – Team B is batting with 1 out with Batter 4 on 3rd base and Batter 6 on 1st base. Batter 7 is in the batter box. Batter 7 has ball, swinging strike, foul (Catcher), ball, ball as the count. The pitch is hit with a mishit soft dribble hit to third base fielder. Third base fielder fields the ball and makes the decision to hold the ball without making a play. All batters are safe on all base. Eg Batter 4-3rd, Batter 6-2nd and Batter 7-1st.

How would you record it?

Answer:

Batter 7 has UFC5 in 1st base

Batter 6 has Advance by Batter 7 – 7 in 2nd base

Batter 4 has no change.

Challenge 1

Note, it isn't a bunt but a mis-hit. The ball starts out in foul territory and rolls back to fair territory. There is a replay following the play.

1st base bobbles the ball in trying to pick it up but recovers enough to throw the ball to second base covering first. The ball arrives at just about the same time as the batter-runner.

How would you record the play?
