- You wanted more communication, more advocacy activities, promotional activities and increased visibility
 - We took this feedback on board, and took steps to achieve these outcomes
- Used the Strategic Plan 2014 2017 as a base and developed a Business Plan which focussed on specific actions
- Here is a summary of TTSA's achievements...





- Committed to a review of our Constitution against 'best practice'
 - engaged and socialised proposed changes
- Re-introduced 'Table Talk'
- Ramped up presence on Social Media





- Introduced >3,500 school children to Table Tennis
- Developed and launched a new website
 - compatible to all types of devices
- Small increase in player numbers
- Ongoing improvement to the development and high performance programs
 - support our athlete pathways





- High levels of participation numbers
 - ~35k recorded
 - however only 5 respondents from all of our affiliates
 - massive opportunity for us here.....
- Increased recorded officiating hours
- Six new officials accredited
- Tweaked the annual presentation night format





- Presence at schools at metropolitan and regional areas
 - coaching clinics and come'n' try days
- Provided bi-monthly President's Newsletter to all affiliates to keep you in the loop about key activities
- Developed and introduced a new website
 - Fantastic feedback from stakeholders (even interstaters)





- Cynthia awarded the '2014 Volunteer of the Year'
 - Presented in front of ~1,000 people at Adelaide
 Oval
- Recognises Cynthia's commitment to Table Tennis over a long and sustained period of time
 - is just recognition of her energy and efforts
 - as a sporting community we can all be proud of this recognition
