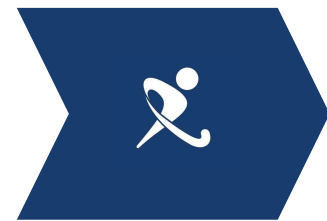
State Team Selection Process



1 - Player Nomination



All players **MUST** nominate for their relevant State Team, even if they are members of the Academy or attending an Open Player Assessment session.



2 - Player Assessment



Players are assessed by the AIO's throughout the Academy Program, and/or at the Open Player Assessment (OPA) session. A Final Player Assessment (FPA) list is published post these events.



3 - Final Player Assessment



Only Selected players attend FPA1, who then potentially progress to FPA2.



4 - State Team Selection



Final Player Assessment 2 is the final phase of the selection process and the State Teams are then announced.



5 - Feedback



Non-selected players from FPA2 can request feedback within 7 days post State Team announcement.

*Every player **MUST** nominate for their relevant State Team, even if you are a member of the Academy. If you are attending an Open Player Assessment session, you **MUST** nominate. Please head to our High Performance Registrations and Nominations page to nominate, or contact the High Performance Team.
