Membership Rollover Guide

Introduction:

Each year, Volleyball NSW individual memberships commence on April 1 and expire on March 31 of the following year.

We seek to make the transition as seamless as possible to allow for registrations to be completed and checked before events on April 1. Membership rollover enables existing members to renew into the 2024 - 2025 membership season.

What is a Rollover?

Rollover is the process of transferring a membership database from the previous membership season to an upcoming membership season. When a membership rollover occurs at the conclusion of the current season, it makes way to apply for the next season's membership.

As of March 31, 2024, your VNSW membership will expire. Memberships will be closed on March 26, 2024, and open back up on March 27, 2024, to facilitate a smooth transition into the new membership season.

VNSW and RevolutioniseSport commit to rolling over all members at the end of March each year. Therefore, your membership will automatically expire to allow you to renew into the new membership season.

How will this impact my Membership?

All current 2023 - 2024 memberships, including insurance, will be valid until March 31, 2024.

The 2024 - 2025 membership period will open for all members to renew on March 27, 2024.

> 2023 - 2024 Current Members

All memberships linked to the existing membership structure for the 2023 - 2024 season will be archived/become inactive March 31, 2024. The memberships will then expire automatically.

Members can renew for the 2024 - 2025 season from March 27, 2024.

* The conditions of Membership require that <u>ALL</u> members who consume volleyball in conjunction with affiliated clubs and VNSW sanctioned events have an active VNSW membership.

NEW - Memberships between January – March 2024

The 3-month Membership option is available to new members who join between January 1 and March 26, 2024. As a result, this membership option will be active only until March 26, when rollover will be completed, however, you will be covered until March 31. It will be necessary for you to renew your membership for the 2024 - 2025 season.





Membership Categories:

A member can upgrade to a higher membership category at any time (fees apply) to access additional services and benefits.

Conditions of Membership

In applying for Membership with VNSW, the individual is acknowledging and agreeing to the following:

- 1. The member will be a member of their Club (where appropriate), VNSW & VA
- 2. All membership, regardless of when first started, will expire on March 31 annually.
- 3. All members are required to register through a VNSW Affiliated Club.

 - b. VNSW reserves the right to allow membership directly to VNSW for some programs & events.
- 4. By joining a VNSW Affiliate, you are automatically joining VNSW. You agree to comply with the rules, regulations, by-laws, and safeguards to ensure that every member has a safe and inclusive environment to participate.
 - a. VNSW reserves the right to cancel any membership for failure to comply.
- 5. Except where provided or required by law and such cannot be excluded, an individual agrees that it is a term of membership (if accepted) that VNSW and VA are absolved from all liability arising from injury or damage however caused (whether fatal or otherwise) arising out of membership and/or participation in any VNSW and VA Activity.
- 6. In consideration of VNSW and VA accepting an application for membership, the individual:
 - a. release and forever discharge VNSW and VA from all claims that they may have or may have had but for this release arising from or in connection with membership and/or participation in any VNSW and VA Activity; and
 - b. indemnify and hold harmless VNSW and VA to the extent permitted by law in respect of any claim by any Person including but not only another Member or Affiliate of VNSW and VA arising as a result of or in connection with membership and/or participation in any VNSW and VA Activity.
- 7. The member declares that they are and must continue to be medically and physically fit and able to participate in any VNSW and VA Activity. They are not and must not be a danger to themselves or the health and safety of others. They will immediately notify VNSW and VA in writing of any change to their fitness and ability to participate. They understand and accept that VNSW and VA will continue to rely upon this declaration as evidence of my fitness and ability to participate.
- 8. An individual warrants that all information they provide to VNSW and VA is true and correct.
- 9. An individual understands that the information they provided is necessary for the objectives of VNSW and VA and acknowledges and agrees that the information will be disclosed by VNSW and VA will only be used for the objects of VNSW and VA general business and to provide membership services. Individuals understand that they will be able to access their information through VNSW. The individual understands that VNSW and VA may also collect, use and exchange my information in other ways as permitted by law.
- 10. An individual acknowledges and consents to photographs being taken of me during my participation in VNSW and VA Activities and acknowledges that the photographs are owned by VNSW and VA and that they may use the photographs for promotional or other purposes without my further consent being obtained. Further, an individual consents to VNSW and VA using their name, image, likeness and also performance in VNSW and VA Activities, at any time, to promote the Activities by any form of media.

Returning Member: Renewing Member

Members who wish to renew membership, please follow these steps

- Please click on the "Returning Member" button
- Follow the prompts of the membership process
- Please choose your membership option
- Ensure you choose the appropriate membership category. If you require assistance, please contact your club or visit the VNSW members section website.
- Please note: If your details are incorrect or do not match your profile when renewing, you will receive an error message
- Renewal: If your membership has expired, the system will allow you to renew it

Returning Member: Adding Club to profile

To add a club to your profile, please follow these steps

- Please click on the "Returning Member" button

- Select the correct membership category when working through this process. For instance, if you have a Full Membership currently, you will need to choose the same membership category when completing this process
