Australian Junior Track & Field Championships





The Australian Junior Track & Field Championships is set to be held at South Australian Athletics Stadium in Adelaide from Thursday 11th – Friday 19th April 2024.

Athletes can qualify to represent Western Australia at the Championships by achieving the entry standard, or by placing top 3 at the WA State Track & Field Championships (22-25 February) in the relevant event/age group.

Australian Little Athletics Championships

The Australian Little Athletics Championships will take place in Adelaide from the 26-28 April 2024. This is a team-based event for Little Athletics U14 athletes. Qualifying for selection will be based on last season's (2022-23) Under 13 athletes that finished 1st, 2nd, and 3rd from the 2023 State Junior Track & Field Championships. Athletes will be invited to register for the Championships between late December and early January via a national registration portal. The registration portal will close on a TBC date. Athletes can select any, or all events, that they have qualified in. Athletes must be registered with the Little Athletics Program to be considered for selection.

This event is not a qualification event for the Australian Track & Field Championships, which will take place in Adelaide from Thursday 11th – Friday 19th April 2024 as the WA State Junior Championships are conducted under Little Athletics Rules.
