



- Two umpires work together to control a match.
- Generally, stay ahead of the play
- As the ball moves closer to the circle you need to start moving in-field
- In the green zone, the umpire in charge is the one who the ball is moving towards – this allows that umpire to control advantage.
- In the blue triangles – the wedge – allows the engaged umpire to blow this if it is going towards the circle – again, they need to control advantage.
- Pre-match, talk through these areas and the corner of the field.
