

NOTICE OF RACE & SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

WASC OPEN TWILIGHT RACE

Friday 10th Feb 2023

Wangi Amateur Sailing Club Open Twilight race - is part of Lakefest Week on Lake Macquarie. It is a **fun race** – no spinnakers, and you don't have to be the fastest to win!

Prizes will be awarded by the organisers to yachts by random draw at a BBQ at the RSL after the race.

Venue: Wangi Amateur Sailing Club (WASC) (Club)

Open to: All sailing boats with a current Category 7 safety certificate

Entry: All boats currently entered in the WASC and LMYC Friday night twilight series will automatically

entered.

All other boats are required to enter online on the WASC web site under "Regattas".

Entry is Free.

An entry by on-line registration system is deemed to have been signed by the owner/skipper who in turn agrees to be bound by the RRS and accepts the risks associated with yacht racing

Closing time for entries 18:00 hours on Thursday 9th February 2023

RULES:

- 1. The race will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS)
- 2 Spinnakers and Gennakers will not be allowed to be used.
- 2. Start will be near NE tip of Fishing Point, between the WASC Committee boat and a red starting mark at the port end of the line. All boats will start in accordance with RRS26. Boats will sail in Divisions as per RKR Series. Boats not sailing in RKR Series will be allocated a division after entering.

Start times: Blue Div - 17:45,

Green Div - 17:50,

White Div - 17:55

- 3. Finish will be between the WASC Flagpole and the WASC Club mark.
- 4. The course will be:

Start (off Fishing Point), Pelican (S) Wangi Point (S), Fishing Point (P) Wangi Club (Finish)

- 5. In the event of a fading wind, the course may be shortened at any mark.
- 6. Any boats retiring are required to advise the WASC RO 0420 855 948 or VHF 77
- 7. Participants will need to be at the RSL presentation to claim their prize

After race (from approximately 7.30pm):

Presentation of prizes, Sausage Sizzle and entertainment at the Wangi RSL Club.

- Entrants sail at their own risk. Injuries to entrants and damage to boats can occur.
- Neither the organising committee nor any other party involved in the organisation of the race shall be held liable for any damage or injury which may occur to any person or property whether ashore or afloat in conjunction with the event.
