- By email two weeks prior to the date they are rostered to be OOD.

<u>It is the OOD's responsibility</u> to arrange a swap with another rostered OOD should they not be available on the identified date. If the OOD does not have a crew, or their crew is not available, then the OOD must find a suitable duty crew replacement.

The OOD, after a reasonable attempt to locate persons to fill the OOD or crew role, may then contact Mike Lawrence to assist them locate another skipper/crew to undertake the role.
