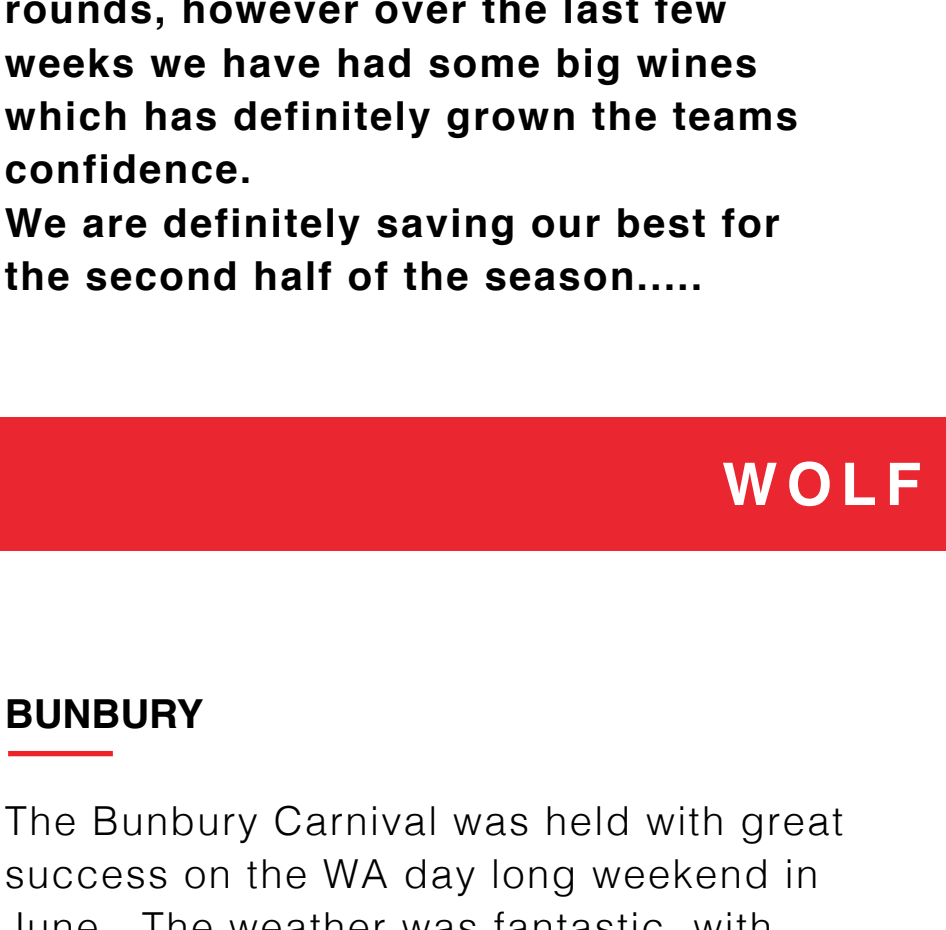

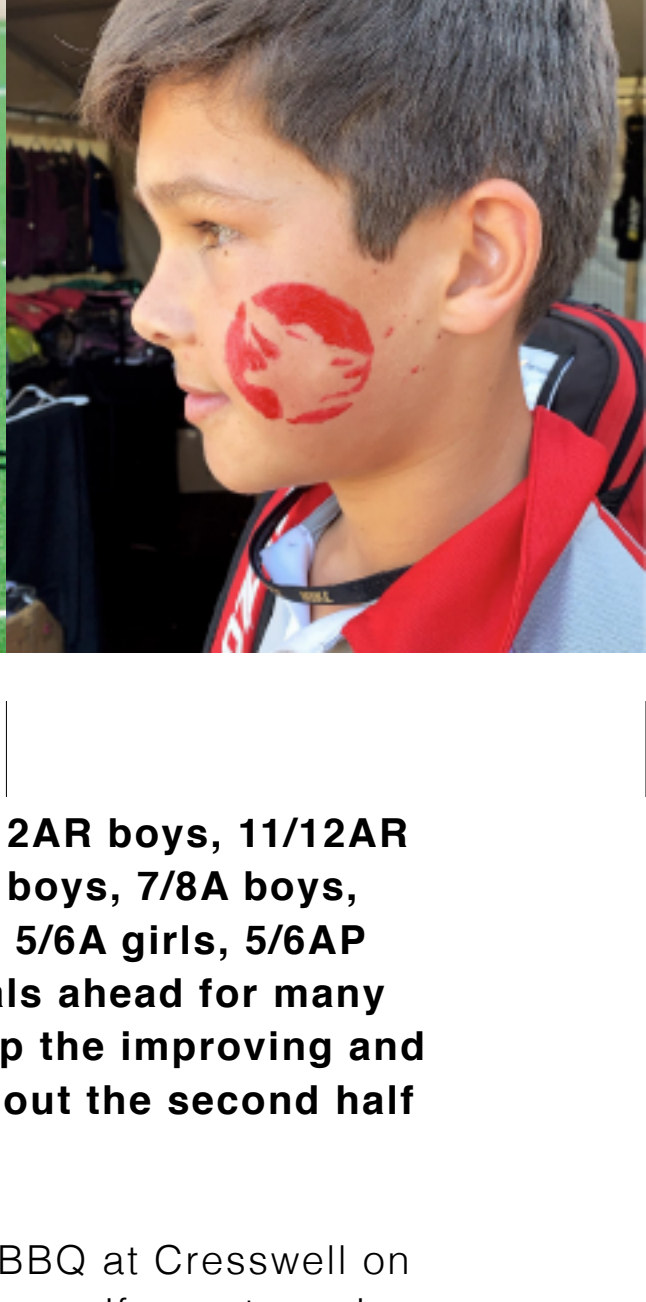
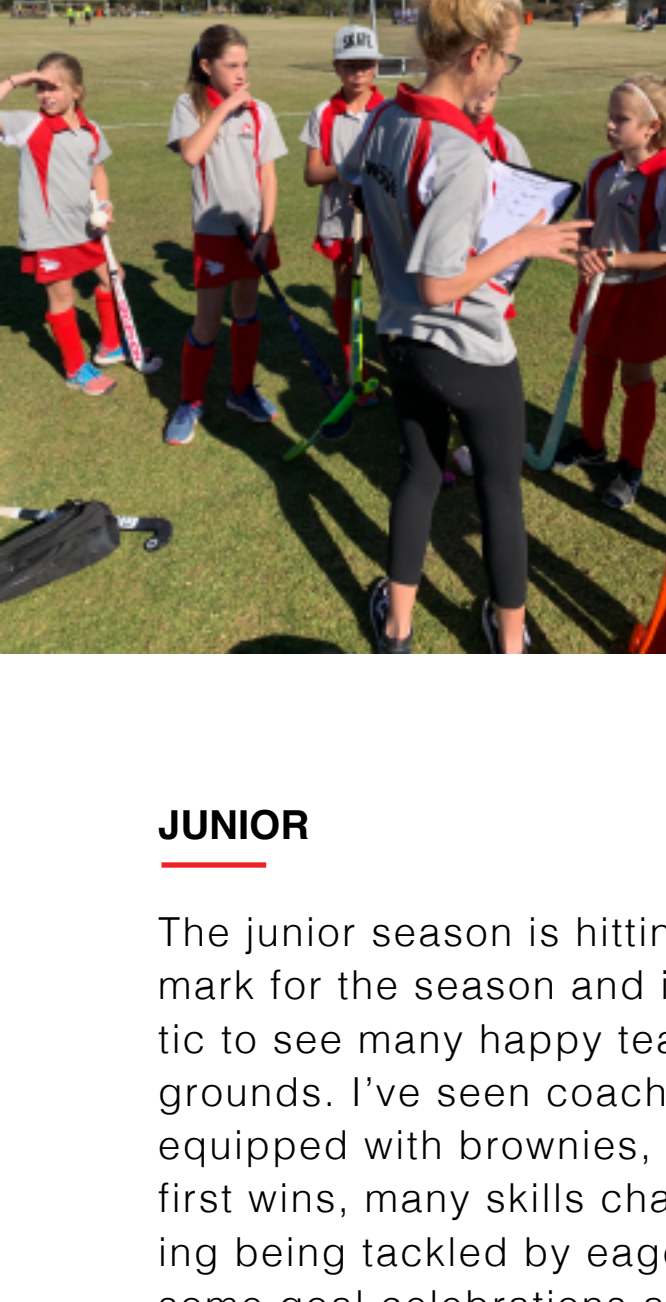
There were dinners out, pizza nights, lots of hanging around chatting and a wine or two drunk.
