The event is an opportunity for athletes around the country to compete against each other in participation event where the focus is not on the end results but the development of skills and being able to interact with other athletes.

Will NAGP squads be selected from this event?

AYWPC is not a selection event for National Age Group Program Squads. NAGP camps will take place during and after the two week competition but these squads have been chosen in advance and athletes will be advised prior to the start of AYWPC if they are expected to attend camps.

Will there be medals and trophies presented?

Yes, medal and trophies will be presented. Gold, Silver, and Bronze medals for each division along with Most Valuable Player and Most Valuable Goalkeeper per age group. The winning teams of the Gold Division will receive a AYWPC trophy.

When will the medals be presented?



Presentations will take place after the conclusion of each gold medal game. Presentations will take place in the Activities Room at the Brisbane Aquatic Centre directly after each gold medal match. Bronze medals may be presented after each of their matches if there is a large break between the Gold and Bronze matches. A presentation schedule will be released closer to the event.

Do teams need to provide Table Officials?

Yes, teams will need to provide 2 table officials for each of their games.

Who can be a table official?

Anyone can be a table official, we recommend prior to the event that your nominated table officials undertake the <u>table official course</u> if they have not been a table official before.

Table officials will be responsible for the new live scoring system as well. Demonstrations on how to use this system will be sent out prior to the start of the competition.

What is the parking situation?

Please note this is a shared space and subject to availability. The car park will close at 30 minutes after the last game. Please note that vehicles are not to be left in the car park. Otherwise, they may be locked in



- overnight. If this does occur, a \$250.00 security callout fee will apply. Please observe standard parking regulations and avoid double parking where possible.

What is the food & beverage situation?

• There are a number of food options close to Fortitude Valley that are a short walk (5-10 minutes). The Valley has a small onsite cafe licensed bar which is licensed from 10am daily.

Somerville House Aquatic Centre

• No onsite food options. Southbank is about a 5min drive from venue.

Musgrave Swim Centre

 Cold Drinks and small food items are available from the canteen. There are a number of food options close to Musgrave Swim Centre.

Café will be open for breakfast, lunch and snacks with coffee, smoothies and shakes as well
as freshly baked goods. Gluten free and vegetarian options available. The Café is situated
poolside with a spacious garden deck.
