



YMCA of Canberra Sailing Club Training Committee Charter

Sailing Club Objects

- 1. The primary object of the Sailing Club shall be to provide a club for members of the Sailing Club to engage in competitive and non-competitive sailing and other aquatic recreation activities.
- 2. In pursuing the primary object, and without limitation, the Sailing Club shall:
 - a. cater for family groups; and
 - b. encourage the participation and training of young people in a manner consistent with the YMCA of Canberra Objects as set out in the Constitution.

Training Committee Object

To support and assist the Rear Commodore Training in the management and conduct of sail and powerboat training activities, with particular focus on the participation and training of young people.

Training Committee Vision

We want students, both children and adults, to:

Have fun;

Be safe;

Learn to sail.

Focus Areas

YMCA of Canberra Sailing Club focus areas include:

- 1. Initial sail training of children and adults, including initial training for families;
- 2. Advanced sail training and coaching for juniors;
- 3. Powerboat training;
- 4. Instructor training and development, particularly Assistant Instructors;
- 5. Advanced sail training and coaching for other Club members; and
- 6. Sail and powerboat training for Sea Scouts, including Sea Scout instructors.

Safety Training

The Training Committee will work with the Sailing Committee to determine and provide any safety training needed to achieve Club objectives.

Constraints

All sail and power boat training shall be conducted in accordance with:

- 1. The Objects of the Sailing Club;
- 2. Australian Sailing requirements for Registered Training Centres;
- 3. YMCA of Canberra (Sailing Club) risk management policies;
- 4. Other relevant YMCA policies and procedures; and
- 5. Any directions by the Sailing Club's Executive.

Exclusions

Training of race officials is a Sailing Committee responsibility.

Schools

Where the YMCA of Canberra Sailing Club is providing training services to a school a representative of that school shall be invited to attend meetings of the Training Committee.

Club Members

Any club member who has a matter that he or she wishes to raise with the Training Committee is encouraged to attend meetings of the Committee to discuss the matter.

Conduct

During the sailing season (September to May) the Training Committee will work as a team and meet when required.

During the off season the Training Committee will meet on an as-required basis.

The Training Committee shall make recommendations to the Club Executive as it sees fit.

The Training Committee will present a report on activities to each meeting of the Club Executive.

Standing items on the agenda of Sailing Committee meetings shall be Risk Management and Working with Children.

The Training Committee shall assist the Rear Commodore Training and the ARC Administrator to prepare a program and budget for the coming season in May of each year.
