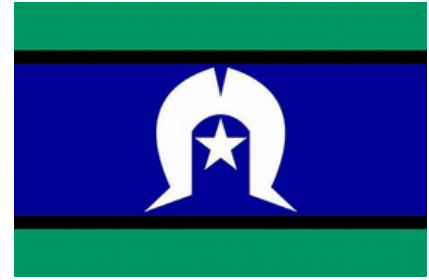

- For the DBNSW Regatta Series Round 2 Racing will commence with Seniors in the morning racing their 500m.
- Premier and Junior categories will commence racing late morning/lunch time with their 500m racing.
- Premier and Junior members are encouraged to get to SIRC, Penrith early to watch the Seniors racing and engage with the entertainment we will have at the event. Likewise, Seniors are welcome to stay after their racing has concluded to watch the Premier and Junior races.

COURSE

- Racing will be conducted on a 500m course
- There will be NO pontoons available for starts at SIRC

SAFETY

- DBNSW will need some helping hands to assist in getting the boats dressed and paddled around to the launch area in the morning and back up to the racks at the conclusion of the event.
