1. Official Title of Competition

2. Organiser

The competition is organised by the Volleyball Association of Singapore (VAS).

3. Date & Venue

The competition dates will be as such:

Registration Closing Date and Time

- VAS will close registration once the maximum of 16 teams per gender.

General Technical Meeting Date and Time

- 21st January 2021, 8.00pm via video conference (Google Meet) link. The link will be sent via email to registered participants on 20th January 2021.
- Attendance for GTM is compulsory, teams must be represented. Proxy of up to one (1) team per person is allowed. Failure to attend will result in forfeiting the competition with no refund of registration fee.

Competition Date and Time

• 30th January 2021, 8.30am onwards (Both genders)

The competition venue will be held at Yio Chu Kang Beach Volleyball Courts (inside Yio Chu Kang Swimming Complex). 202 Ang Mo Kio Avenue 9, Singapore 569771.

All participants must register at the Holding Area (Image 1) at least 10 minutes before their first match of the day with their photo ID for verification. Both players MUST be present for this.

4. Registration Fee

The registration fee for each team is SGD\$40.00. The fee must be paid before the start of GTM. Otherwise, the registration will be considered as invalid.

9. Competition Regulations

- On top of the existing regulations stated in this set of Rules & Regulations, the Championship will follow the rules and regulations set by FIVB.
- If a team fail to appear with 10 minutes of the stipulated match time, the team is deemed to have forfeited the match.
- Should any controversial incidents occur which are not stated in the regulations, the Organizing Committee will be responsible for settling the dispute. Any decision made by the Organising Committee is final.

10. Uniforms

- Male players are not allowed to play without shirts. Both players have to be similarly dressed (same jerseys, and same-coloured shorts with length not below the knee).
- Female players must wear matching tops. Bottoms/briefs have to be of the same colour and design between partners but need not necessarily match their tops.
- Team names on jerseys are not compulsory.
- Socks are permitted, should the sand be deemed too hot with the permission of the tournament director.
- Footwear is not permitted.
- Compression wear during competition is allowed.

11. Contingency

- The Championship will stop in the event of lightning risk.
- The Organising Committee holds the right to alter fixtures, tournament format and/or scoring system, or to postpone the tournament to a revised weekend, should unforeseen bad weather or other circumstances prohibit the tournament to be completed as scheduled.
- The Organising Committee will make announcements and/or inform all team captains of any changes.


- It is also the teams' responsibility to await further instructions from the Organising Committee on days of the tournament.
