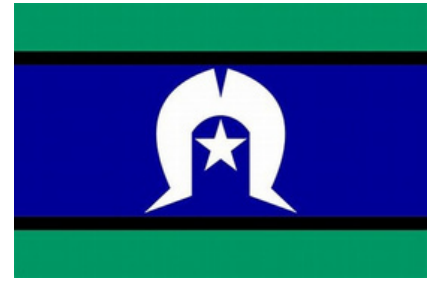

KEY REGATTA INFORMATION



DRAW

- Race draw was released week commencing Monday 8 August and emailed out to all clubs participating and posted on the DBNSW Winter Warmer event page.

- Racing will commence with Seniors in the morning racing their 100m.
- 1km Pursuit racing for ALL categories will commence late morning.
- Juniors and Prems will commence race late morning/lunch time with their 100m racing.
- Junior and Prems are encouraged to get to Kurnell early to watch the Senior racing and engage with the entertainment we will have at the event. Likewise, Seniors are welcome to stay after their racing has concluded to watch the Junior and Prems paddlers.

COURSE

- Racing will be conducted at a minimum of 100m from shore to ensure enough depth is available.
- Being a beach location, Kurnell is not very protected, therefore wind could play a factor on the day of racing. So, we ask that all clubs work with our officials to ensure we can move through the race timetable quickly and complete the published timetable.
- DBNSW are working to find contingency venues so please keep this in mind on the day.

SAFETY

- DBNSW will need a some helping hands to assist in getting the boats down to the beach in the morning and back up to the racks at the commencement of the event. As this will include walking the boats on 'soft' sand, DBNSW will be providing appropriate flooring to prevent any injuries occurring during the process.
- Kurnell like any beach location is prone to having shells and sticks in the sand, all members/paddlers MUST wear enclosed shoes.
- The break-wall rocks which encloses our area of racing will be blocked off from access so please do not try to climb onto the rocks for viewing or any reason.
- Please do not peg down your tents on the grass. DBNSW encourage clubs to bring weight/sandbags as an alternative.
- COVID Aware
 - If you feel unwell, have symptoms of Covid-19 or have tested positive for Covid-19. Please do not attend the Regatta.
 - It is recommended to wear a face mask when you can't physically distance from others.
 - Practice good hygiene, wash your hands regularly or use hand sanitiser
