## NOTICE OF RACE



### 1. Rules

The Tiwi Islands Yacht Race (hereafter referred to as RACE) will be governed by the rules, as defined in

1. Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)
2. Current IRC Rules Parts A, B & C where applicable (Div1)
3. Australian Sailing Special Regulations Safety Category 3 PLUS
4. International Rules for Prevention of Collision at Sea (IRPCS) at night
5. Sailing Instructions
6. Notice of Race
7. DBCYA Safety Recommendations

### 2. Eligibility & Entry

1. [Online entry](#) is via Revsport
2. Entries close @ 1700hrs Friday 31<sup>st</sup> May 2019.
3. Documentation required upon entry include
  - Skipper's Sailing Portfolio
  - Yacht AIS details
  - Crew list including Next of Kin and Australian Sailing No.
  - Yacht photo

### 3. Divisions

#### ***Division 1 – ORC Club Monohull***

ORC Certificate & Cat 3 PLUS Safety.

#### ***Division 1 – PHS Monohull***

Cat 3 PLUS Safety

#### ***Division 2 - PHS Multihull***

Cat 3 PLUS Safety.

### 4. Fees

The entry fee is \$50/boat/division (alternatively in-kind prize donations will be considered).

## **5. Schedule**

1. Race Briefing at DBCYA – 18:00 Thursday 6<sup>th</sup> June 2019
2. Race Start – 09:00 Saturday 8<sup>th</sup> June 2019
3. The scheduled time of the first warning signal is 08:55.
4. Presentation at DBCYA – 18:30 Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> June 2019

## **6. Sailing Instructions**

Sailing instructions will be available after 1600 on Friday 31<sup>st</sup> May 2019.

## **7. The Race**

1. The start of the race shall be a line between the flagpole on the Dinah Beach Trailer, in the Dudley Point carpark, East Point to No.6 Buoy in Darwin Harbour.
2. The course is a circumnavigation of the Tiwi Islands, leaving Melville Island and Bathurst Island to PORT.
3. The finish line shall be between Dudley Point and No.7 Buoy in Darwin Harbour.
4. Yachts are to take their own finish time.
5. The course is approximately 300nm.

## **8. Communications**

Race Frequency VHF CH73 for sign on, start and recalls.
