**NOTICE OF RACE**

**1 RULES**

**1.1** The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-20* and Australian Sailing (AS) Special Regulations (SR) Part 1 for Racing Boats, the Australian Trailable Yacht and Sports Boat Rule (ATYSBR) and the relevant class rules, except as any of these are altered by the Sailing Instructions.

**1.2 Safety Regulations**

- (a) SA SR Category 6 shall apply PLUS an engine shall be carried at all times in conformity with the requirements of the YA SR Part 1 - 2.01.6 Category 5 and 3.24.3 and 3.24.5 Propulsion.
- (b) Boats are required to display the Australian Sailing safety category 6 (or less) compliance sticker on the transom.
- (c) Keels shall be locked down at all times while racing.
- (d) Boats shall not race with anchors protruding over any part of the boat gunwale.

**2 ADVERTISING**

Competitors may be required to display Series or Event sponsor's name(s) or logo(s) and bow numbers. If required, the Organising Authority will supply these items and they shall be affixed as prescribed in the Sailing Instructions.

**3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 3.1** Yachts complying with the "Trailable Boat" or "Sports Boat" definition as detailed in YA SR Part 1, for Racing Boats, item 1.03.1 will be allowed entry.
- 3.2** All skippers and crew must hold a membership (silver or gold card) with Australian Sailing.



(A **Racing Day Pass** will be available for those crew without a membership – refer **14. Further Information**.)

- 3.3 Racing will be conducted in several divisions. The separation of the divisions may vary depending on entries with a CBH of 0.700 used as a guide for a break in divisions. Sports Boats will race in a separate division.
- 3.4 Eligible boats shall enter online electronically only, through the GLYC website -[Click Here](#) by the Closing Date, 1700 hours, Wednesday 18 March 2020.
- 3.5 The entry fee payable on line is \$70.00. Late entries will be taken up until the close of registration and will incur an additional late entry fee of \$30.00.
- 3.6 Crew details shall be provided at Registration, including Australian Sailing Silver Card number and emergency contacts.

## 6 VENUE

Racing will be conducted on the Gippsland Lakes, Lake Victoria.

## 7 COURSES

The courses will be Windward-Leeward courses around laid marks, as per the Sailing Instructions.



**9 BERTHING**

Boats may be berthed in the vicinity of the GLYC. Please observe the public berthing restrictions.

**10 RADIO COMMUNICATION**

Except in an emergency a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

**11 PRIZES**

Prizes made up of trophies and vouchers provided by sponsors and Yachting Victoria will be awarded to 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> calculated on CBH for each Division and 1<sup>st</sup> overall, 2013 Victorian Trailable Yacht Champion.

Class Association trophies and other division prizes may be awarded subject to number of entries.

**12 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

**13 INSURANCE**

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid public liability insurance with a minimum cover of **\$10,000,000** per event or the equivalent.
