1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 The Australian Sailing Prescriptions and Special Regulations for Off the Beach Boats shall apply.
- 1.3 The Constitution and Rules of the Flying Fifteen Association shall apply.
- 1.4 Appendix T "Arbitration" will apply.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 Eligible boats may enter using the online form HERE Entries close on Friday 15th March, 2019.
- 3.2 Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Organising Authority.

- 5.3 On the last scheduled day or racing, no warning signal shall be made after 1200.

6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

7 **REGATTA VENUE**

- 7.1 The Regatta venue will be Royal Freshwater Bay Yacht Club, Keanes Point, Peppermint Gove, Western Australia.
- 7.2 The race area will be Melville Water West.

8. **COURSES**

8.1 The courses to be sailed shall be described in the Sailing Instructions.

9. **PENALY SYSTEM**

RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turn Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

10. **SCORING**

- 10.1 Two races are required to constitute a series.
- 10.2 When fewer than five (5) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 10.3 When from five (5) to six (6) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

PRIZES 11

Prizes will be awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd Places overall.

Further prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the Organising Authority.

12 **DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The Organising Authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$10M per incident or equivalent.
