CENTRE RULES

- THE CENTRE ACCEPTS NO RESPONSIBILITY FOR PERSONAL

- PLEASE USE BINS PROVIDED FOR ALL RUBBISH
- LOUSY BEHAVIOUR WILL NOT BE TOLERATED
- THE CENTRE MANAGEMENT RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REFUSE

SAFETY REGULATIONS

- A MAXIMUM OF SIX (6) PERSONS ARE TO USE ANY ONE NET AT ONE
TIME
- PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT (INCLUDING HELMETS) IS COMPULSORY
AND TO BE WORN AT ALL TIMES
- THE CRICKET CENTRE AND CRICKET NSW ACCEPT NO LIABILITY FOR
ANY INJURIES INCURRED DURING NET USE
- ONLY APPROVED FOOTWEAR IS TO BE WORN WHILST IN THE NETS

CONDITIONS OF USE

- PAYMENT MUST BE MADE PRIOR TO USE OF THE NETS
- LEAVE NETS AS YOU FOUND THEM AFTER SESSIONS END
- DO NOT REMOVE ANY EQUIPMENT (STUMPS ETC) FROM THE CENTRE
- PERSONS UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF ALCOHOL WILL NOT BE
PERMITTED TO USE THE NETS
