



## PENNANT SERIES 2015/2016 RULES AND CRITERIA

1. Pennant levels carry over from the previous Pennant season for those divers who continue into the current season. Divers that have been non-competitive for at least 12 months are not constricted to their previous Pennant levels.
2. All divers who have competed in Age/Masters events **must** enter at Pennant 6 or above for the springboard that they competed. Exceptions:
  - a. 50+ Masters may enter at Pennant Level 4.
  - b. 11 & U and 12/13 divers may enter at Pennant 5 if a national qualifying score was not achieved.
3. Divers who have competed in Elite Junior events in the current or previous season **must** enter at Pennant 8 or above for the springboard they competed. NEPP divers must enter in Level 6 or above for Springboard.
4. Divers who have competed in Open events in the current or previous season must enter at Pennant 9 or above for that board.
5. Divers **must** enter at a Pennant level equal to or higher than the highest level they have previously dived. Junior divers who compete in Open Pennant may compete in Pennant 10 in subsequent weeks.
6. Divers may enter at a higher Pennant level if they choose.
7. Divers may compete a springboard event and a platform event in all Pennant weeks.
8. in Springboard events, divers must do all dives from either 1M or 3M, they may not mix boards.
9. If in Pennant 1 & 2 a diver fails a dive or falls off the board, the referee may give a re- dive, the points for the re-dive will not count.
10. If a diver scores the Pennant score for springboard either 1M or 3M they must enter at a higher level when diving on the same board in subsequent Pennants. They may be on a different Pennant level for 1m, 3m and platform.
11. Junior divers who qualify in Pennant 10 may continue in Pennant 10.
12. One jump OR entry is allowed at all levels of Pennant except where criteria specifies 2 jumps in Pennants 1 & 2. DD will be 1.0. In a jump the arms may be above the head or by the side. A diver will NOT achieve their Pennant in Levels 4 and above if performing a jump or entry.
13. Synchro, Team and Skills events when offered, will be exhibition only and will not earn club or individual points.
14. Divers who train at MSAC during Diving Victoria times are expected to participate in a minimum of two Pennant competitions each season.
15. The Competition Manager reserves the right to combine events, and if necessary, change the order of events if required for the smooth running of the competition.
16. The weekly competition timetable will be available on the website ([www.divingvictoria.com.au](http://www.divingvictoria.com.au)) the Friday morning prior to the event.
