# **NOTICE OF RACE**

#### 1 RULES

- **1.1** The event is governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules Of Sailing*.
- **1.2** The SA Sailing prescriptions for National and Regional Championships will apply.
- **1.3** RRS Appendix T (Arbitration) will apply.

# **2 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

The sailing instructions will be posted on the Virtual Notice Board and class website no later than 12-00 on 28 September 2021 and will be available at registration.

#### 3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- **3.1** The regatta is open to all boats of the ILCA 7, 6 & 4 classes.
- **3.2** Age Categories will be defined by the age of the competitor at the time of registration.
- **3.3** Eligible boats may enter by registering online at: https://www.revolutionise.com.au/laserclasssa/events/109190/
- 3.4 To be considered an entry in the event, a boat shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees. Fees to be paid to: Redhouse Yacht Club banking account: Standard Bank, cheque account, Account no: 080 507 409.
- 3.5 Late entries will be accepted at the venue up to 12-00 on Friday 1 October 2021
- 3.6 All competitors shall be members in good standing of SA Sailing and of a yacht club affiliated to and in good standing with SA Sailing (or their equivalent in the case of non-South Africans) and legally permitted to compete. They must be members of the South African ILCA Class Association.
- **3.7** Proof of such membership shall be presented at registration.

#### 4 FEES

Entry fees are as follows:

**R800-00** and **R600-00** (under 26) by 17 September 2021. Late entry fees are **R1,200-00** and **R1,000-00** (under 26)

#### **5 ADVERTISING**

[DP] Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organising authority.

#### 6 SCHEDULE

- **6.1** Registration: 1/10/2021, from 9:00 to 12:00 (noon).
- **6.2** Equipment inspection and event measurement: 1/10/2021, from 9:00 to 12:00 (noon).
- **6.3** Dates of racing: 1/10/2021 to 4/10/2021
- **6.4** The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race is: 14:00.
- **6.5** A maximum of 12 races are scheduled.
- **6.6** On the last scheduled day of racing no warning signal will be made after 15:00.

#### 7 MEASUREMENT

Boats shall be available for equipment inspection from 1/10/2021.

#### 8 SUPPORT PERSON VESSELS

[DP] Support person vessels shall be marked with white flag.

#### 9 PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded as follows:

15 - 19 boats (in a class) Gold, Silver

20 or more boats (in a class) Gold, Silver, Bronze
